Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Walking around the neighborhood, one is bound to notice that the war of decorations in preparation for Halloween is on! I wish more people were familiar with the Christian origins of Halloween. The very name "Halloween" is a contraction of "All Hallows Eve", that is, the vigil of All Saints Day (November 1). Therefore, All Hallows Eve is a time for us to prayerfully reflect on the lives of the saints, for they remind us of our heavenly home where death has no place.

Unfortunately, we cannot say that that is the case for many who get into the festivities associated with Halloween these days. In some instances, Halloween has been hijacked by a tendency to glamorize the occult and all that borders on the demonic. While this might sound extreme to some, we cannot deny its veracity. What should we do then as Catholics? Is it Ok to participate in Halloween celebrations, and to go trick-or-treating?

I believe we can, but we should do so as Catholics! Here are some suggestions to consider: Attend Mass and make time to pray. We will have Mass on All Hallows Eve, All Saints Day (November 1st), as well as on All Souls Day (November 2nd). See **page 6** for the Mass schedule for these days, which are collectively referred to as "Allhallowtide". Allhallowtide is a special time to remember and pray for the dead. Let us therefore ask the saints to pray for us so that we may not lose sight of the heavenly calling; and secondly, let us pray for all the dead, especially those we have known.

In this week's bulletin also, you will find the **Novena** for the Souls in Purgatory (Page 11), which can be offered for the holy souls in purgatory. As is our custom, we have also placed in the entrance to the church, the **Book of Remembrance** where you can write down the names of your beloved deceased relatives and loved ones. Throughout the month of November, we will be offering prayers for them at Mass.

Finally, we encourage everyone to decorate their front porches with images of saints and religious symbols that represent our Catholic faith. Parents, remember to teach your children about the Christian origins of Halloween and if they will be going trick-or-treating, encourage them to dress as saints.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridísimos amados en Cristo:

Al caminar por el vecindario, uno se da cuenta de que la guerra de decoraciones en preparación para Halloween está en marcha. Ojalá más gente estuviera familiarizada con los orígenes cristianos de Halloween. El nombre mismo "Halloween" es una contracción de "All Hallows Eve", es decir, la vigilia del Día de Todos los Santos (1 de noviembre). Por lo tanto, All Hallows Eve es un momento para que reflexionemos en oración sobre las vidas de los santos, ya que nos recuerdan nuestro hogar celestial donde la muerte no tiene lugar.

Lamentablemente, no podemos decir que ese sea el caso de muchos de los que participan en las festividades asociadas con Halloween en estos días. En algunos casos, Halloween ha sido secuestrado por una tendencia a glorificar el ocultismo y todo lo que bordea lo demoníaco. Si bien esto puede sonar extremo para algunos, no podemos negar su veracidad. ¿Qué deberíamos hacer entonces como católicos? ¿Está bien participar en las celebraciones de Halloween y salir a pedir dulces?

Creo que podemos, ¡pero deberíamos hacerlo como católicos! Aquí hay algunas sugerencias para tener en cuenta: Asista a Misa y tómese un tiempo para orar. Tendremos Misa en la Víspera de Todos los Santos, el Día de Todos los Santos (1 de noviembre), así como en el Día de los Fieles Difuntos (2 de noviembre). Vea la **página 6** para el horario de Misas para estos días, que se conocen colectivamente como "Allhallowtide". Allhallowtide es un momento especial para recordar y orar por los muertos. Por lo tanto, pidamos a los santos que oren por nosotros para que no perdamos de vista el llamado celestial; y en segundo lugar, oremos por todos los muertos, especialmente por aquellos que hemos conocido.

En el boletín de esta semana también encontrará la **Novena** por las Almas del Purgatorio (página 11), que se puede ofrecer por las almas santas del purgatorio. Como es nuestra costumbre, también hemos colocado en la entrada de la iglesia, el **Libro del Recuerdo** donde puede escribir los nombres de sus familiares y seres queridos fallecidos. Durante todo el mes de noviembre, ofreceremos oraciones por ellos en la misa.

Por último, animamos a todos a decorar sus porches delanteros con imágenes de santos y símbolos religiosos que representen nuestra fe católica. Padres, recuerden enseñar a sus hijos sobre los orígenes cristianos de Halloween y, si van a ir a pedir dulces, animenlos a vestirse como santos.

Somos: **una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡Amén!**
