Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This is the patronal feast day of our parish. We pray that through the intercessions of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, our families may be sustained in grace, joy and fellowship, and that the families of the world may grow in mutual love and understanding, Amen!

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph demonstrates for us the centrality of obedience to God. Though the Son of God, Jesus was obedient to his foster father, St. Joseph, and his Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary. And St. Joseph we know, was willing to forego his plans and to lovingly accept the plans and will of God for him and the members of the Holy Family.

God is our Heavenly Father and he desires that all of his children should share in the graces and blessings of the Holy Family. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, show us the way to accept the invitation of the Heavenly Father. Let us humbly ask for the graces to say Yes to the Father's will and plans for us as did the members of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. Amen!

Finally, it is with great delight that we welcome His Excellency, Bishop Italo Dell'Oro, once again to our Parish as he celebrates the Opening Mass for the **Year of Jubilee** at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica. In this Year of Jubilee, may the families of the world experience the peace, joy and love that come from our Savior, Jesus. Amen!



SAFE ENVIRONMENT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR SUSPECTED ABUSE OF A MINOR

The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston requires compliance with applicable laws regarding incidents of actual or suspected child abuse including abuse involving child on child conduct. Failure to report suspected physical or mental abuse or neglect of a child in Texas is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both.

PERMISSION TO MAKE A REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED OR EXPECTED. ERR ON THE SIDE OF MAKING A GOOD FAITH REPORT RATHER THAN FAILING TO DO SO.


