Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today marks the beginning of **Catholic** Schools Week, which is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. Since Galveston was the site of the first Catholic school in Texas and Catholic education continues to thrive here even today, we have much to celebrate! Holy Family Catholic School is the school of choice here in Galveston for families who are seeking an academically rigorous education for their children in a setting where students develop a strong Catholic identity.

At Holy Family Catholic School, students and staff are truly "united in faith and community." We pray together each day during morning assembly, at lunch, and at dismissal.
