Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today marks the beginning of **Catholic Schools Week**, which is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. Since Galveston was the site of the first Catholic school in Texas and Catholic education continues to thrive here even today, we have much to celebrate! Holy Family Catholic School is the school of choice here in Galveston for families who are seeking an academically rigorous education for their children in a setting where students develop a strong Catholic identity.

At Holy Family Catholic School, students and staff are truly "united in faith and community." We pray together each day during morning assembly, at lunch, and at dismissal. Students prepare for sacraments of First Communion and First Reconciliation in their religion class during the school day with their classmates. Also, every Friday we celebrate Mass or Adoration and Reconciliation. Students sing in the choir, serve as altar servers, lectors, and ushers at the weekly Mass.

As parents, you are seeking a school community where your child will receive a rigorous education that meets their individual needs and you will find that at Holy Family Catholic School. The small classes provide a learning environment that is conducive to targeted instruction where the teachers understand the needs of each student and have the opportunity to provide individualized instruction. With the data provided by the MAP Growth Assessment taken by the students three times each school year, our experienced teachers understand the strengths and weaknesses of each student and address them with carefully planned lessons.

The school brought back athletics last year with a volleyball team, a basketball team, and a track team. Also, as student council returns to the school, students have the opportunity to develop leadership skills and to serve others. Students participate in the school's science fair and spelling bee with some of them advancing to the archdiocesan competitions for these events.

Parents are an important part of the school community. You are recognized as your child's first and best teachers and the school seeks to actively partner with all of our students' parents. I encourage all of the parents in our parish to prayerfully consider giving your child the gift of a Catholic education. Not sure if the school is right for you or your child? Schedule a tour for you and your child. Not sure if you can afford a private school education? Call and talk to our principal. Over 85% of our students receive tuition assistance.

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Hoy comienza la Semana de las Escuelas Católicas, que es la celebración anual de la educación católica en los Estados Unidos. Dado que Galveston fue el sitio de la primera escuela católica en Texas y la educación católica continúa prosperando aquí incluso hoy, ¡tenemos mucho que celebrar! La Escuela Católica Holy Family es la escuela elegida aquí en Galveston por las familias que buscan una educación académicamente rigurosa para sus hijos en un entorno donde los estudiantes desarrollen una fuerte identidad católica.

En la Escuela Católica Holy Family, los estudiantes y el personal están verdaderamente "unidos en la fe y la comunidad". Oramos juntos todos los días durante la asamblea de la mañana, en el almuerzo y a la hora de la salida. Los estudiantes se preparan para los sacramentos de la Primera Comunión y la Primera Reconciliación en su clase de religión durante el día escolar con sus compañeros de clase. Además, todos los viernes celebramos la Misa o la Adoración y la Reconciliación. Los estudiantes cantan en el coro, sirven como monaguillos, lectores y acomodadores en la misa semanal.

Como padres, buscan una comunidad escolar donde su hijo reciba una educación rigurosa que satisfaga sus necesidades individuales y la encontrarán en la Escuela Católica Holy Family. Las clases pequeñas brindan un entorno de aprendizaje propicio para una instrucción específica donde los maestros comprenden las necesidades de cada estudiante y tienen la oportunidad de brindar instrucción individualizada. Con los datos proporcionados por la Evaluación de Crecimiento MAP que toman los estudiantes tres veces por año escolar, nuestros maestros experimentados comprenden las fortalezas y debilidades de cada estudiante y las abordan con lecciones cuidadosamente planificadas.

La escuela recuperó el atletismo el año pasado con un equipo de voleibol, un equipo de baloncesto y un equipo de atletismo. Además, como el consejo estudiantil regresa a la escuela, los estudiantes tienen la oportunidad de desarrollar habilidades de liderazgo y servir a los demás. Los estudiantes participan en la feria de ciencias y el concurso de ortografía de la escuela y algunos de ellos avanzan a las competencias arquidiocesanas para estos eventos.

Los padres son una parte importante de la comunidad escolar. Ustedes son reconocidos como los primeros y mejores maestros de su hijo y la escuela busca asociarse activamente con todos los padres de nuestros estudiantes. Animo a todos los padres de nuestra parroquia a que consideren en oración darle a su hijo el regalo de una educación católica. ¿No está seguro de si la escuela es adecuada para usted o su hijo? Programe una visita para usted y su hijo. ¿No está seguro de si puede pagar una educación en una escuela privada? Llame y hable con nuestro director. 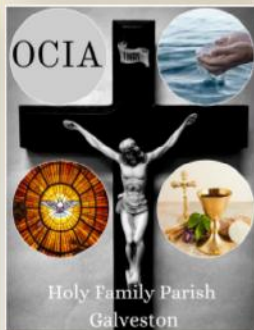

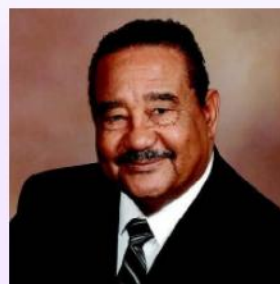

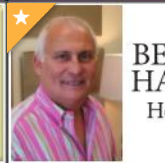
