Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Up until now we have been having Confessions on Wednesdays (from 4:30PM to 5:30PM) at St. Patrick's Church. I am very delighted to announce that we have finally installed new Confessionals in the Ursuline Chapel at the new Parish Life Center. Therefore, starting from this coming Wednesday, February 26th, our Wednesday Confessions will no longer be taking place at St. Patrick's Church; it will now be at the Ursuline Chapel. Kindly take note of this change in location for the midweek confessions.

This change helps to simplify both the location and schedule for our weekday liturgical celebrations, So, now, both our weekday Masses as well as the midweek confession (on Wednesdays) will be taking place in the same location — the Ursuline Chapel. And when we begin the Lenten Season this year, we will also be having the Stations of the Cross (both in English and in Spanish) at the Ursuline Chapel as well.

Speaking of the Lenten Season, it begins on **Ash Wednesday, March 5**th. On **page 11** of this bulletin, you will find the complete schedule for Ash Wednesday celebrations and the distribution of ashes, as well as the schedule for the Stations of the Cross throughout this season of Lent.

Let us keep in mind that Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence. All those who are between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday (which means those in this category may eat only one full meal and two smaller meals that together do not add up to a full meal). In addition, all those who are over 14 years old are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on Fridays throughout Lent.

This year, we will be having our Parish Lenten Mission/Reconciliation from Monday, March 10th to Wednesday March 12th. The venue will be St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica; time, 6:30PM. On the last day (March 12th), we will have a Lenten Penance Service with Confessions. Our presenter for this year's Lenten Mission is Fr. Augustine Adetola, the Pastor of St. Peter Claver Catholic Church, in Houston, Texas. For more details, please see page 11.

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Hasta ahora hemos estado teniendo confesiones los miércoles (de 4:30 p.m. a 5:30 p.m.) en la Iglesia de San Patricio. Estoy muy feliz de anunciar que finalmente hemos instalado nuevos confesionarios en la Capilla de las Ursulinas en el nuevo Centro de Vida Parroquial. Por lo tanto, a partir del próximo miércoles 26 de febrero, nuestras confesiones de los miércoles ya no se llevarán a cabo en la Iglesia de San Patricio; ahora serán en la Capilla de las Ursulinas. Tome nota de este cambio de ubicación para las confesiones de mitad de semana.

Este cambio ayuda a simplificar tanto la ubicación como el horario de nuestras celebraciones litúrgicas de los días de semana, por lo que, ahora, tanto nuestras misas de los días de semana como la confesión de mitad de semana (los miércoles) se llevarán a cabo en el mismo lugar: la Capilla de las Ursulinas. Y cuando comencemos la temporada de Cuaresma este año, también tendremos el Vía Crucis (tanto en inglés como en español) en la Capilla de las Ursulinas.

Hablando de la temporada de Cuaresma, ésta comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza, el 5 de marzo. En la página 11 de este boletín, encontrará el programa completo de las celebraciones del Miércoles de Ceniza y la distribución de las cenizas, así como el programa de las Estaciones de la Cruz durante esta temporada de Cuaresma.

Tengamos en cuenta que el Miércoles de Ceniza es un día de ayuno y abstinencia. Todos aquellos que tengan entre 18 y 59 años deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza (lo que significa que aquellos en esta categoría pueden comer solo una comida completa y dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no sumen una comida completa). Además, todos aquellos que tengan más de 14 años deben abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y los viernes durante la Cuaresma.

Este año, tendremos nuestra Misión/Reconciliación Parroquial de Cuaresma del lunes 10 de marzo al miércoles 12 de marzo. El lugar será la Basílica Catedral de Santa María; hora, 6:30 p.m. El último día (12 de marzo), tendremos un Servicio de Penitencia Cuaresmal con Confesiones. Nuestro presentador para la Misión Cuaresmal de este año es el Padre Augustine Adetola, el Pastor de la Iglesia Católica St. Peter Claver, en Houston, Texas. 

DISCERNMENT PROCESS

Holy Family Catholic School will be hosting a discernment process for those who think that God may be calling them to serve the school as a member of our Advisory School Council. An Advisory School Council is not like a public school board which hires, fires, and sets policy. Per Archdiocesan guidelines, the Advisory School Council acts in an advisory and consultative capacity to the Principal and Pastor, and assists both the Principal and Pastor by recommending policy and by identifying and articulating the needs and aspirations of the school community. They serve as "Good-Will Ambassadors" for Holy Family Catholic School. Council members will be selected through a process of discernment with prayer and reflection. Those interested in being considered for membership should attend the discernment meeting and participate in the discernment process. The Council generally meets once each month and members serve for a term of three years, with the option to serve a second term if they discern that God is calling them to do so. 




Theme: Christian Hope and the Uncertainties of Life






