Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Welcome to the holy season of Lent! Ash Wednesday is this week and it is the start of the season of Lent. For the full Ash Wednesday schedule, see page 11 in this bulletin. You can also find this information on the parish website. Also, kindly note that we have moved the location for Wednesday Confessions (4:30-5:30PM) as well as the evening Stations of the Cross on Fridays (at 5:30PM in English and at 7PM in Spanish) from St. Patrick's Church to the Ursuline Chapel at the new Parish Life Center.

Starting next weekend, we will be resuming our *Conversations with the Saints* Lenten Series. If you would recall, this Series focuses on the reflections of the saints about this holy season of Lent. We learn from their exemplary life and are inspired by their words to follow Christ more faithfully, especially as we observe the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Lent is a period for us to pause in prayer and to listen more attentively to God and to our neighbors as well. In our Gospel Reading today, Jesus invites us to bear good fruits — fruits of righteousness, which leads to joy and peace. In order to accomplish this, we have to ensure that our hearts and our minds are first nourished by the graces of God. The fruits we bear, as Jesus instructs us in today's Gospel, will be a reflection of our inner state.

So, where are you inwardly? What is going on in your life in this moment? How is God present in your life? As you reflect on these and similar questions, we would like to invite you to join us for our **Parish Lenten Mission and Penance Service**, from Monday to Wednesday (March 10-12). The venue is St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica and each session in the evening starts at 6:30PM. On the last day of the Mission (Wednesday), we will have Penance Service and Confessions.

Lent is a time to follow Jesus into the desert. It is a time to distance ourselves from life's distractions so as to focus more intently on God and the things of God. As we seek to do this, may these words of St. Francis de Sales be our guide: "Have patience with all things, but first of all with yourself".

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

DISCERNMENT PROCESS

Holy Family Catholic School will be hosting a discernment process for those who think that God may be calling them to serve the school as a member of our Advisory School Council. An Advisory School Council is not like a public school board which hires, fires, and sets policy. Per Archdiocesan guidelines, the Advisory School Council acts in an advisory and consultative capacity to the Principal and Pastor, and assists both the Principal and Pastor by recommending policy and by identifying and articulating the needs and aspirations of the school community. They serve as "Good-Will Ambassadors" for Holy Family Catholic School. Council members will be selected through a process of discernment with prayer and reflection. Those interested in being considered for membership should attend the discernment meeting and participate in the discernment process. The Council generally meets once each month and members serve for a term of three years, with the option to serve a second term if they discern that God is calling them to do so. 




