Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

For this week's *Conversations with the Saints* Lenten series, let us meditate with the following reflections on prayer by St. John Vianney –

Consider, children, a Christian's treasure is not on earth, it is in heaven. Well then, our thoughts should turn to where our treasure is. Man has a noble task: that of prayer and love. To pray and to love, that is the happiness of man on earth.

Prayer is nothing else than union with God. When the heart is pure and united with God it is consoled and filled with sweetness; it is dazzled by a marvelous light. In this intimate union God and the soul are like two pieces of wax molded into one; they cannot any more be separated. It is a very wonderful thing, this union of God with his insignificant creature, a happiness passing all understanding.

We had deserved to be left incapable of praying; but God in his goodness has permitted us to speak to him. Our prayer is an incense that is delightful to God. My children, your hearts are small, but prayer enlarges them and renders them capable of loving God. Prayer is a foretaste of heaven, an overflowing of heaven. It never leaves us without sweetness; it is like honey, it descends into the soul and sweetens everything.

In a prayer well made, troubles vanish like snow under the rays of the sun.

Prayer makes time seem to pass quickly, and so pleasantly that one fails to notice how long it is. ... There are those who lose themselves in prayer, like a fish in water, because they are absorbed in God. There is no division in their hearts. How I love those noble souls! Saint Francis of Assisi and Saint Colette saw our Lord and spoke to him as we speak to one another.

As for ourselves, how often do we come to church without thinking what we are going to do or for what we are going to ask. And yet, when we go to call upon someone, we have no difficulty in remembering why it was we came. Some appear as if they were about to say to God: 'I am just going to say a couple of words, so I can get away quickly.' I often think that when we come to adore our Lord we should get all we ask if we asked for it with a lively faith and a pure heart.

This Lent, make time for prayer and be intentional about praying.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Para la serie de Cuaresma de Conversaciones con los Santos de esta semana, meditemos con las siguientes reflexiones sobre la oración de San Juan Vianney:

Hijos míos, el tesoro del cristiano no está en la tierra, está en el cielo. Pues bien, nuestros pensamientos deben dirigirse a dónde está nuestro tesoro. El hombre tiene una noble tarea: la de la oración y el amor. Orar y amar, esa es la felicidad del hombre en la tierra.

La oración no es otra cosa que la unión con Dios. Cuando el corazón es puro y está unido a Dios, se consuela y se llena de dulzura; se deslumbra con una luz maravillosa. En esta íntima unión, Dios y el alma son como dos piezas de cera fundidas en una sola; ya no pueden separarse. Es algo maravilloso, esta unión de Dios con su insignificante criatura, una felicidad que sobrepasa todo entendimiento.

Merecíamos ser incapaces de orar; pero Dios, en su bondad, nos ha permitido hablarle. Nuestra oración es un incienso que deleita a Dios. Hijos míos, sus corazones son pequeños, pero la oración los ensancha y los capacita para amar a Dios. La oración es un anticipo del cielo, un desbordamiento del cielo. Nunca nos deja sin dulzura; es como la miel, desciende al alma y lo endulza todo.

En una oración bien hecha, las penas se desvanecen como la nieve bajo los rayos del sol. La oración hace que el tiempo parezca pasar rápido, tan agradablemente que uno no se da cuenta de cuánto tiempo pasa. ... Hay quienes se pierden en la oración, como pez en el agua, porque están absortos en Dios. No hay división en sus corazones. ¡Cuánto amo a esas almas nobles! San Francisco de Asís y Santa Coleta vieron a nuestro Señor y le hablaron como nosotros hablamos entre nosotros.

En cuanto a nosotros, ¿cuántas veces venimos a la iglesia sin pensar en lo que vamos a hacer ni en lo que vamos a pedir? Y, sin embargo, cuando vamos a visitar a alguien, no nos cuesta recordar por qué vinimos. Algunos parecen estar a punto de decirle a Dios: «Solo voy a decir un par de palabras para irme rápido». A menudo pienso que cuando adoramos a nuestro Señor, deberíamos recibir todo lo que pedimos si lo pedimos con una fe viva y un corazón puro.

Esta Cuaresma, dedica tiempo a la oración y ora con dedicación.

Somos: una sola Parroquia Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!
