

## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today's Gospel reading about the woman who was caught in adultery invites us to reflect deeper on God's mercy, which offers hope and redemption to sinners, that is, to all of us. Our sins made us enemies of God but in and through Christ, he redeemed and reconciled us back to himself. He calls us therefore to imitate this love by loving our enemies and praying for those who persecute us. Our **Conversations with the Saints** Lenten series below by St. Aelred, takes up these themes –

The perfection of brotherly love lies in the love of one's enemies. We can find no greater inspiration for this than grateful remembrance of the wonderful patience of Christ. He who is more fair than all the sons of men offered his fair face to be spat upon by sinful men; he allowed those eyes that rule the universe to be blindfolded by wicked men; he bared his back to the scourges; he submitted that head which strikes terror in principalities and powers to the sharpness of the thorns; he gave himself up to be mocked and reviled, and at the end endured the cross, the nails, the lance, the gall, the vinegar, remaining always gentle, meek and full of peace....

Who could listen to that wonderful prayer, so full of warmth, of love, of unshakeable serenity -Father, forgive them - and hesitate to embrace his enemies with overflowing love? Father, he says, forgive them. Is any gentleness, any love, lacking in this prayer?

Yet he put into it something more. It was not enough to pray for them: he wanted also to make excuses for them. Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing. They are great sinners, yes, but they have little judgment; therefore, Father, forgive them. They are nailing me to the cross, but they do not know who it is that they are nailing to the cross: if they had known, they would never have crucified the Lord of glory; therefore, Father forgive them. ... I have hidden my face from them, and they do not recognize my glory; therefore, Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.

If someone ... wishes to resist the promptings of his sinful nature he must enlarge the whole horizon of his love to contemplate the loving gentleness of the humanity of the Lord. Further, if he wishes to savor the joy of brotherly love with greater perfection and delight, he must extend even to his enemies the embrace of true love.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

El Evangelio de hoy, sobre la mujer sorprendida en adulterio, nos invita a reflexionar más profundamente sobre la misericordia de Dios, que ofrece esperanza y redención a los pecadores, es decir, a todos nosotros. Nuestros pecados nos hicieron enemigos de Dios, pero en Cristo, y por medio de él, él nos redimió y nos reconcilió consigo mismo. Por lo tanto, nos llama a imitar este amor amando a nuestros enemigos y orando por quienes nos persiguen. Nuestra serie de Cuaresma, **"Conversaciones con los Santos**", de San Elredo, aborda estos temas:

La perfección del amor fraternal reside en el amor a los enemigos. No hay mayor inspiración para esto que el recuerdo agradecido de la maravillosa paciencia de Cristo. Él, más hermoso que todos los hijos de los hombres, ofreció su hermoso rostro para que lo escupieran los pecadores; permitió que los ojos que gobiernan el universo fueran vendados por los malvados; se desnudó ante los azotes; sometió la cabeza que infunde terror en los principados y potestades a la agudeza de las espinas. Se entregó a la burla y al vituperio, y al final soportó la cruz, los clavos, la lanza, la hiel, el vinagre, permaneciendo siempre manso, humilde y lleno de paz...

¿Quién podría escuchar esa maravillosa oración, tan llena de calidez, de amor, de serenidad inquebrantable —Padre, perdónalos— y dudar en abrazar a sus enemigos con amor desbordante? Padre, dice, perdónalos. ¿Acaso falta dulzura, amor, en esta oración?

Sin embargo, puso algo más. No bastaba con orar por ellos: también quería excusarlos. Padre, perdónalos, porque no saben lo que hacen. Son grandes pecadores, sí, pero tienen poco juicio; por eso, Padre, perdónalos. Me están clavando en la cruz, pero no saben a quién están clavando en la cruz: si lo hubieran sabido, nunca habrían crucificado al Señor de la gloria; por eso, Padre, perdónalos... Les he ocultado mi rostro, y no reconocen mi gloria; Por tanto, Padre, perdónalos, porque no saben lo que hacen.

Si alguien... desea resistir las incitaciones de su naturaleza pecaminosa, debe ampliar todo el horizonte de su amor para contemplar la bondad amorosa de la humanidad del Señor. Además, si desea saborear la alegría del amor fraternal con mayor perfección y deleite, debe extender incluso a sus enemigos el abrazo del verdadero amor.

Somos: una sola Parroquia Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!




### FIFTH WEEK OF LENT UNITED IN GENEROSITY AS ONE GLOBAL FAMILY




