Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Palm Sunday ushers in Holy Week, when we celebrate the greatest mysteries of our redemption. Our *Conversations with the Saints* Lenten Series this week is from a homily given by St. Andrew of Crete, in which he exhorts us to welcome Christ into our very lives with humility, as we celebrate the beginnings of Holy Week -

Let us go together to meet Christ on the Mount of Olives. Today he returns from Bethany and proceeds of his own free will toward his holy and blessed passion, to consummate the mystery of our salvation. He who came down from heaven to raise us from the depths of sin, to raise us with himself, ... now comes of his own free will to make his journey to Jerusalem. He comes without pomp or ostentation. ...

Let us run to accompany him as he hastens toward Jerusalem, and imitate those who met him then, not by covering his path with garments, olive branches or palms, but by doing all we can to prostrate ourselves before him by being humble and by trying to live as he would wish. Then we shall be able to receive the Word at his coming, and God, whom no limits can contain, will be within us.

In his humility Christ entered the dark regions of our fallen world and he is glad that he became so humble for our sake, glad that he came and lived among us and shared in our nature in order to raise us up again to himself. And even though we are told that he has now ascended above the highest heavens—the proof, surely, of his power and godhead—his love for man will never rest until he has raised our earthbound nature from glory to glory, and made it one with his own in heaven.

So let us spread before his feet, not garments or soulless olive branches, which delight the eye for a few hours and then wither, but ourselves, clothed in his grace, or rather, clothed completely in him. We who have been baptized into Christ must ourselves be the garments that we spread before him. Now that the crimson stains of our sins have been washed away in the saving waters of baptism and we have become white as pure wool, let us present the conqueror of death, not with mere branches of palms but with the real rewards of his victory. Let our souls take the place of the welcoming branches as we join today in the children's holy song: *Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Blessed is the king of Israel.*

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

El Domingo de Ramos inaugura la Semana Santa, cuando celebramos los mayores misterios de nuestra redención. Nuestra serie de *Conversaciones con los Santos* de Cuaresma de esta semana se basa en una homilía de San Andrés de Creta, en la que nos exhorta a acoger a Cristo en nuestras vidas con humildad, al celebrar el inicio de la Semana Santa.

Vayamos juntos al encuentro de Cristo en el Monte de los Olivos. Hoy regresa de Betania y se dirige voluntariamente hacia su santa y bendita pasión, para consumir el misterio de nuestra salvación. Él, que bajó del cielo para sacarnos de las profundidades del pecado, para resucitarnos consigo mismo, ahora viene voluntariamente a Jerusalén. Viene sin pompa ni ostentación.

Corramos a acompañarlo en su apresurado camino hacia Jerusalén, e imitemos a quienes lo encontraron entonces, no cubriendo su camino con vestiduras, ramas de olivo o palmas, sino haciendo todo lo posible por postrarnos ante él con humildad y tratando de vivir como él desearía. Entonces podremos recibir la Palabra a su venida, y Dios, a quien no hay límites que puedan contener, estará en nosotros.

En su humildad, Cristo entró en las regiones oscuras de nuestro mundo caído y se alegra de haberse hecho tan humilde por nosotros, de haber venido a vivir entre nosotros y de haber compartido nuestra naturaleza para elevarnos de nuevo hacia sí mismo. Y aunque se nos dice que ya ha ascendido a los cielos más altos —la prueba, sin duda, de su poder y divinidad—, su amor por el hombre no descansará hasta que haya elevado nuestra naturaleza terrenal de gloria en gloria, y la haya hecho una con la suya en el cielo.

Así que, extendamos ante sus pies, no vestiduras ni ramas de olivo sin alma, que deleitan la vista por unas horas y luego se marchitan, sino a nosotros mismos, revestidos de su gracia, o mejor dicho, revestidos completamente de él. Nosotros, que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo, debemos ser las vestiduras que extendamos ante él. Ahora que las manchas carmesí de nuestros pecados han sido lavadas en las aguas salvadoras del bautismo y nos hemos vuelto blancos como la lana pura, presentemos al vencedor de la muerte, no con simples ramas de palma, sino con la verdadera recompensa de su victoria. Que nuestras almas ocupen el lugar de las ramas que nos dan la bienvenida al unirnos hoy al canto sagrado de los niños: *Bendito el que viene en el nombre del Señor. Bendito el Rey de Israel.*

Somos: **una sola Parroquia Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

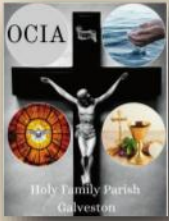


PALM SUNDAY

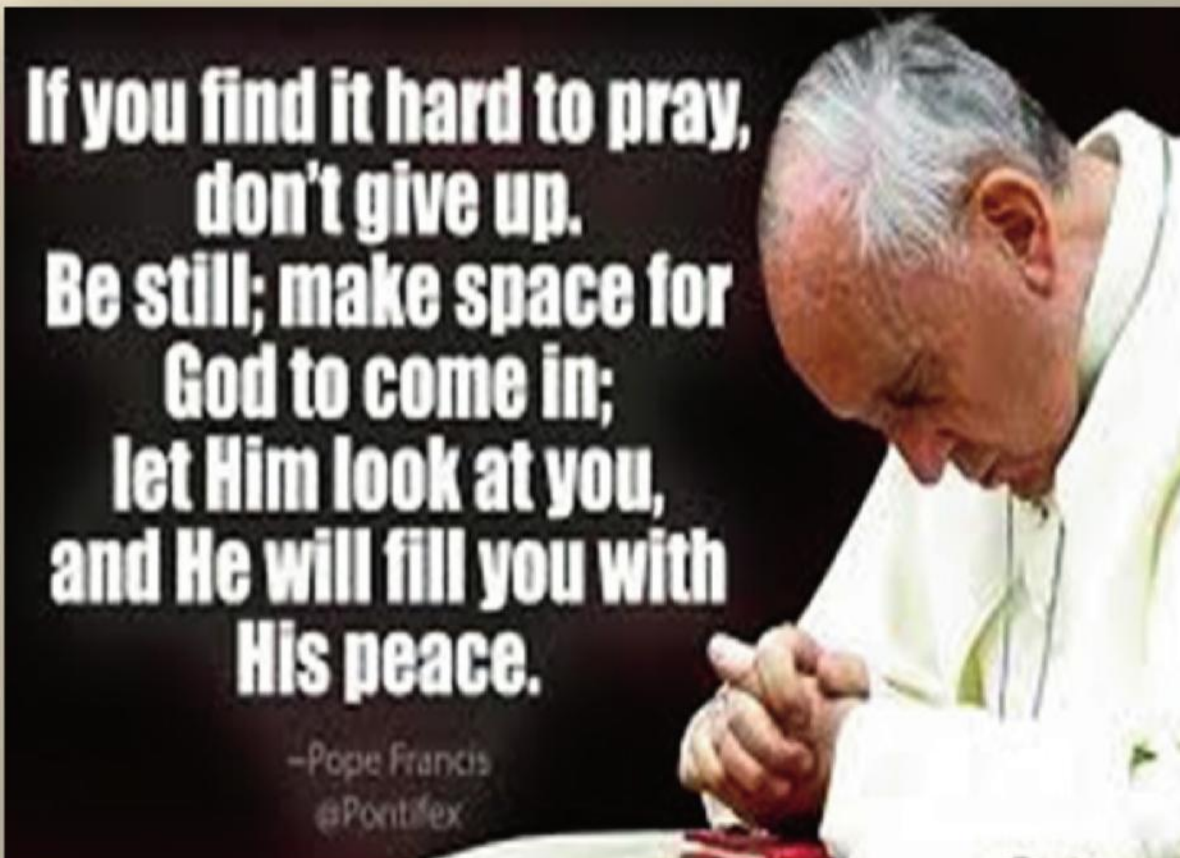




OCIA and Adult Confirmation

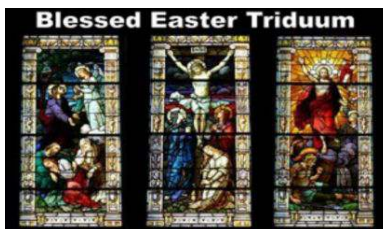



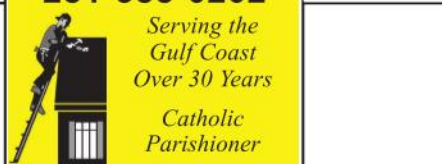
