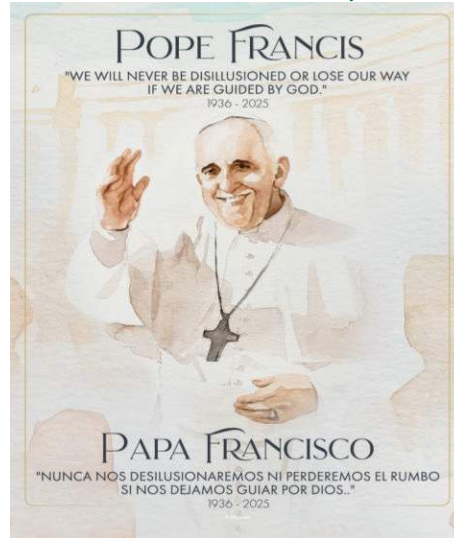

Capital Campaign

IT IS REALLY TRUE!

In November 2024, we announced that a very generous parishioner offered to MATCH up to \$400,000. in new pledges from November 2024 through November 30, 2025 (the final date of Phase I of the Capital Campaign to raise \$5.5 million).

During this time, we have received over \$272,000 in new pledges. We only need \$128,000 in new pledges to be awarded the full match of \$400,000. Here is the major news...when we receive the \$128,000 in new pledges, we will have achieved our goal of \$5.5 million in pledges. Additionally, these new pledges of \$128,000 will bring us within \$300,000 of collecting the full \$5.5 million, which would mean that we were able to raise 100% of our Campaign goal!!! This is crucial as it would ensure that we are able to complete Phase 1 of our Capital Campaign project debt-free.

Our 850 generous parishioners have blazed this trail to such a successful campaign. It's not too late to join us as we count down to this parish victory. May God continue to watch over our parish as we celebrate the Easter Season.

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As you are all aware by now, our dear and beloved Pope Francis died on Easter Monday. Let us pray that the Lord whom he served so faithfully on earth may now welcome him into his heavenly kingdom, Amen! There will be a Memorial Mass offered for him this coming **Saturday, May 3rd at St. Mary's**, starting at **8am**. All are invited to attend.

For the next seven weekends, we will be unpacking the mysteries of the gift of Easter, which commemorates the gift of our redemption through the Death and Resurrection of Christ our Lord. Christ died to save us from our sins and to demonstrate the limitless mercy of God for us.

Today, the Sunday after Easter, is known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. God's merciful love in Christ Jesus is the true and only source of lasting peace for troubled humanity. In today's Gospel, we encounter the disciples of Christ who were imprisoned by fear, guilt, sorrow, and a deep sense of loss. Christ comes into their midst, bringing them peace and removing from them all that was holding them captive.

"Peace be with you," Christ says to them. The peace that Christ brings cannot be separated from the gift of the forgiveness of sins. Christ has given to his Church and her ministers the ability to forgive sins and to restore peace: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." We receive this peace that comes from the forgiveness of sins through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We only need to have faith and trust in God who in his mercy has given us this Sacrament of healing and restoration.

Pope Francis reminds us that God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who get tired of asking him for his mercy and forgiveness. We simply need to trust and ask. Let us now ask God to grant him his mercy and welcome him into his kingdom as we pray: ***"Go forth, Holy Father Francis, from this world in the Name of God the Almighty Father, who created you; in the name of Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, Who suffered for you; and in the Name of the Holy Spirit, Who was poured out upon you. Go forth, faithful Christian. May you live in peace this day, may your home be with God in Zion, with Mary, the Virgin Mother of God, with Joseph, and all the Angels and Saints. Amen!"***

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Como ya saben, nuestro querido y amado Papa Francisco falleció el Lunes de Pascua. Oremos para que el Señor, a quien sirvió tan fielmente en la tierra, lo reciba ahora en su reino celestial. ¡Amén! Se ofrecerá una Misa en su memoria este próximo **sábado 3 de mayo en la iglesia de Santa María**, a partir de las 8:00am. Todos están invitados a asistir.

Durante los próximos siete fines de semana, profundizaremos en los misterios del don de la Pascua, que conmemora el don de nuestra redención mediante la Muerte y Resurrección de Cristo, nuestro Señor. Cristo murió para salvarnos de nuestros pecados y demostrarnos la infinita misericordia de Dios.

Hoy, domingo después de Pascua, se conoce como el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. El amor misericordioso de Dios en Cristo Jesús es la única y verdadera fuente de paz duradera para la humanidad atribulada. En el Evangelio de hoy, nos encontramos con los discípulos de Cristo, aprisionados por el miedo, la culpa, la tristeza y un profundo sentimiento de pérdida. Cristo entra en medio de ellos, les trae paz y les quita todo aquello que los mantenía cautivos.

"La paz esté con ustedes", les dice Cristo. La paz que Cristo trae es inseparable del don del perdón de los pecados. Cristo ha dado a su Iglesia y a sus ministros la capacidad de perdonar los pecados y restaurar la paz: "Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonen los pecados, les quedarán perdonados, y a quienes se los retengan, les quedarán retenidos". Recibimos esta paz que proviene del perdón de los pecados mediante el Sacramento de la Reconciliación. Solo necesitamos tener fe y confianza en Dios, quien en su misericordia nos ha dado este Sacramento de sanación y restauración.

El Papa Francisco nos recuerda que Dios nunca se cansa de perdonarnos; somos nosotros los que nos cansamos de pedirle su misericordia y perdón. Simplemente necesitamos confiar y pedir. Pidamos ahora a Dios que le conceda su misericordia y le dé la bienvenida a su reino mientras oramos: ***"Sal, Santo Padre Francisco, de este mundo en el nombre de Dios Padre Todopoderoso, que te creó; en el nombre de Jesucristo, Hijo de Dios vivo, que sufrió por ti; y en el nombre del Espíritu Santo, que fue derramado sobre ti. Ve adelante, fiel cristiano. Que vivas en paz este día, que tu hogar esté con Dios en Sión, con María, la Virgen Madre de Dios, con José y todos los ángeles y santos. ¡Amén!"***

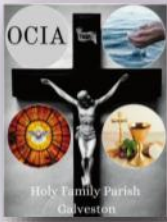

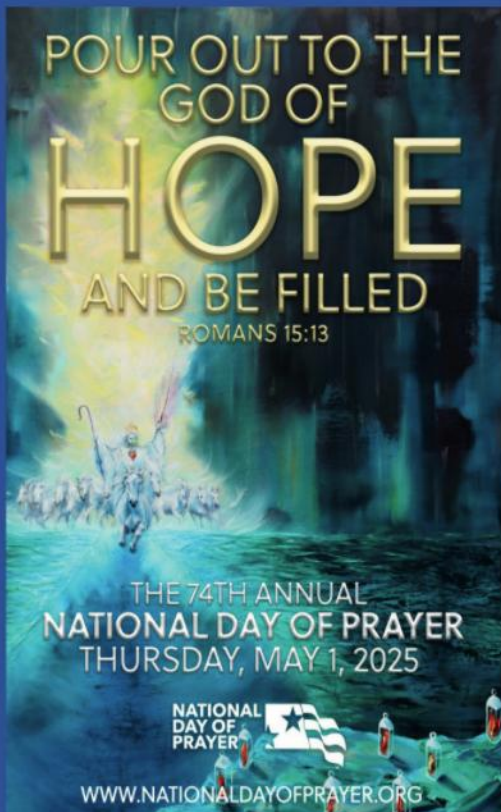

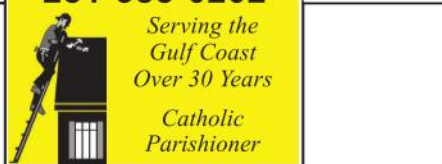
