IT IS REALLY TRUE!

In November 2024, we announced that a very generous parishioner offered to MATCH up to \$400,000. in new pledges from November 2024 through November 30, 2025 (the final date of Phase I of the Capital Campaign to raise \$5.5 million).

During this time, we have received over \$272,000 in new pledges. We only need \$128,000 in new pledges to be awarded the full match of \$400,000. Here is the major news...when we receive the \$128,000 in new pledges, we will have achieved our goal of \$5.5 million in pledges. Additionally, these new pledges of \$128,000 will bring us within \$300,000 of collecting the full \$5.5 million, which would mean that we were able to raise 100% of our Campaign goal!!! This is crucial as it would ensure that we are able to complete Phase 1 of our Capital Campaign project debt-free.

Our 850 generous parishioners have blazed this trail to such a successful campaign. It's not too late to join us as we count down to this parish victory. May God continue to watch over our parish as we celebrate the Easter Season.

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Our *Conversations with the Saints* series now shifts to cover post-Resurrection themes. In other words, they help us to unpack the implications of Easter for us. In today's Gospel, Christ provides a meal for his troubled disciples. He does likewise for us today through, and in the Eucharist. The excerpts below are from a reflection on the Eucharist by St. Justin Martyr -

No one may share the eucharist with us unless he believes that what we teach is true, unless he is washed in the regenerating waters of baptism for the remission of his sins, and unless he lives in accordance with the principles given us by Christ.

We do not consume the eucharistic bread and wine as if it were ordinary food and drink, for we have been taught that as Jesus Christ our Savior became a man of flesh and blood by the power of the Word of God, so also the food that our flesh and blood assimilates for its nourishment becomes the flesh and blood of the incarnate Jesus by the power of his own words contained in the prayer of thanksgiving.

The apostles, in their recollections, which are called gospels, handed down to us what Jesus commanded them to do. They tell us that he took bread, gave thanks and said: Do this in memory of me. This is my body. In the same way he took the cup, he gave thanks and said: This is my blood. ...On Sunday we have a common assembly of all our members, whether they live in the city or the outlying districts. The recollections of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read, as long as there is time. When the reader has finished, the president of the assembly speaks to us; he urges everyone to imitate the examples of virtue we have heard in the readings. Then we all stand up together and pray.

On the conclusion of our prayer, bread and wine and water are brought forward. The president offers prayers and gives thanks to the best of his ability, and the people give assent by saying, "Amen." The eucharist is distributed, everyone present communicates, and the deacons take it to those who are absent....

Let us therefore approach the Eucharist with reverence, with faith, and with a conscience free from mortal sins, that we may receive the Lord worthily with gratitude.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Nuestra serie "*Conversaciones con los Santos*" ahora aborda temas posteriores a la Resurrección. En otras palabras, nos ayudan a comprender las implicaciones de la Pascua para nosotros. En el Evangelio de hoy, Cristo ofrece un alimento a sus discípulos atribulados. Hace lo mismo por nosotros hoy a través de la Eucaristía y en ella. Los siguientes extractos son de una reflexión sobre la Eucaristía de San Justino Mártir:

Nadie puede compartir la Eucaristía con nosotros a menos que crea que lo que enseñamos es verdad, a menos que sea lavado en las aguas regeneradoras del bautismo para la remisión de sus pecados, y a menos que viva de acuerdo con los principios que Cristo nos dio.

No consumimos el pan y el vino eucarísticos como si fueran comida y bebida ordinarias, pues se nos ha enseñado que, así como Jesucristo, nuestro Salvador, se hizo hombre de carne y sangre por el poder de la Palabra de Dios, también el alimento que nuestra carne y sangre asimila para nutrirse se convierte en la carne y sangre de Jesús encarnado por el poder de sus propias palabras contenidas en la oración de acción de gracias.

Los apóstoles, en sus recuerdos, llamados evangelios, nos transmitieron lo que Jesús les mandó hacer. Nos dicen que tomó el pan, dio gracias y dijo: «Hagan esto en memoria mía. Este es mi cuerpo». Del mismo modo, tomó la copa, dio gracias y dijo: «Esta es mi sangre». ...El domingo tenemos una asamblea común con todos nuestros miembros, ya vivan en la ciudad o en las afueras. Se leen los recuerdos de los apóstoles o los escritos de los profetas, siempre que haya tiempo. Cuando el lector termina, el presidente de la asamblea nos habla; Él insta a todos a imitar los ejemplos de virtud que hemos escuchado en las lecturas. Luego, todos nos ponemos de pie y oramos juntos.

Al concluir nuestra oración, se presenta el pan, el vino y el agua. El que preside ofrece oraciones y da gracias lo mejor que puede, y el pueblo asiente diciendo: «Amén». Se distribuye la Eucaristía, todos los presentes comulgan y los diáconos la llevan a los ausentes...

Acerquémonos, pues, a la Eucaristía con reverencia, con fe y con una conciencia libre de pecados mortales, para que recibamos al Señor dignamente y con gratitud.

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!

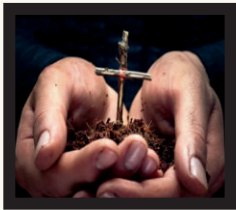

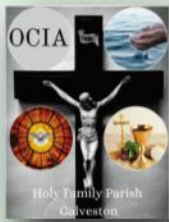
