IT IS REALLY TRUE!

In November 2024, we announced that a very generous parishioner offered to MATCH up to \$400,000. in new pledges from November 2024 through November 30, 2025 (the final date of Phase I of the Capital Campaign to raise \$5.5 million).

During this time, we have received over \$272,000 in new pledges. We only need \$128,000 in new pledges to be awarded the full match of \$400,000. Here is the major news...when we receive the \$128,000 in new pledges, we will have achieved our goal of \$5.5 million in pledges. Additionally, these new pledges of \$128,000 will bring us within \$300,000 of collecting the full \$5.5 million, which would mean that we were able to raise 100% of our Campaign goal!!! This is crucial as it would ensure that we are able to complete Phase 1 of our Capital Campaign project debt-free.

Our 850 generous parishioners have blazed this trail to such a successful campaign. It's not too late to join us as we count down to this parish victory. May God continue to watch over our parish as we celebrate the Easter Season.

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today's Gospel forms part of the final testament Christ gives to his disciples prior to his crucifixion (see John 13-17). Imagine the father of a household addressing his family, aware that he is about to die. He gives them words of advice that would help them thrive in life. Similarly, we hear Jesus addressing us as his children: "My Children, I will be with you only a little while longer. I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."

Why is this a new commandment? This is because it calls us to use the love of God as our yardstick for evaluating how we show love. Our tendency as humans is to be selective with our affection and this can be based on our mood, interests, associations — be they familial, professional, philanthropic or otherwise, etc. God's love on the other hand does not discriminate. It is wholly self-giving, and Jesus demonstrates this to us by dying on the cross for us. Christ repeats this commandment to love as he loves two chapters later (in John 15:12), followed by this assertion: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."

Christ shows his love for us by dying for us even while we were still sinners, that is, enemies of God on account of our sins. In other words, through his death, he makes us friends of God, for his death is our reconciliation and his resurrection, our life. When did you last show kindness to an enemy? Have you ever expressed sacrificial love to someone who has wronged you? How do you treat those you consider to be your enemies? Do you choose the path of vengeance and ill-will toward those who have hurt you or do you intentionally act with love toward them to seek reconciliation? Do you love like Christ?

Today, Christ invites us to truly ponder on this *new* commandment of love. If we seek to abide by it, it will *renew* our world, one heart — one relationship, one family, etc. — at a time. And Jesus tells us why we should love as he loves: "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

El Evangelio de hoy forma parte del testamento final que Cristo da a sus discípulos antes de su crucifixión (ver Juan 13-17). Imaginemos al padre de familia dirigiéndose a su familia, consciente de que está a punto de morir. Les da consejos que les ayudarán a prosperar en la vida. De igual manera, escuchamos a Jesús dirigiéndose a nosotros como hijos suyos: "Hijos míos, estaré con vosotros poco tiempo más. Os doy un mandamiento nuevo: que os améis los unos a los otros. Como yo os he amado, que también os améis los unos a los otros".

¿Por qué es este un mandamiento nuevo? Porque nos llama a usar el amor de Dios como criterio para evaluar cómo demostramos amor. Como seres humanos, tendemos a ser selectivos con nuestro afecto, y esto puede basarse en nuestro estado de ánimo, intereses, relaciones — ya sean familiares, profesionales, filantrópicas o de otro tipo—, etc. El amor de Dios, en cambio, no discrimina. Es una entrega total, y Jesús nos lo demuestra muriendo en la cruz por nosotros. Cristo repite este mandamiento de amar como él ama dos capítulos después (en Juan 15:12), seguido de esta afirmación: «Nadie tiene amor más grande que este: dar la vida por sus amigos».

Cristo demuestra su amor por nosotros muriendo por nosotros incluso cuando aún éramos pecadores, es decir, enemigos de Dios a causa de nuestros pecados. En otras palabras, mediante su muerte, nos hace amigos de Dios, porque su muerte es nuestra reconciliación y su resurrección, nuestra vida. ¿Cuándo fue la última vez que mostraste bondad a un enemigo? ¿Alguna vez has expresado amor sacrificial a alguien que te ha hecho daño? ¿Cómo tratas a quienes consideras tus enemigos? ¿Eliges el camino de la venganza y la mala voluntad hacia quienes te han hecho daño o actúas intencionalmente con amor hacia ellos para buscar la reconciliación? ¿Amas como Cristo?

Hoy, Cristo nos invita a reflexionar verdaderamente sobre este nuevo mandamiento del amor. Si nos esforzamos por seguirla, renovará nuestro mundo, un solo corazón —una sola relación, una sola familia, etc.— a la vez. Y Jesús nos dice por qué debemos amar como él ama: «En esto conocerán todos que son mis discípulos: si se aman los unos a los otros».

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!




OCIA and Adult Confirmation
