Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of Christ into heaven. Christ ascends to heaven, not to abandon us, but to present us before the Father! We have two choices for the Second Reading today, one from St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians (1:17-23) and the other, from the Letter to the Hebrews (9:24-28; 10:19-23). The second choice from the Letter to the Hebrews presents us with a cultic and liturgical lens to view Christ's ascension. The Author declares that Christ ascends into the heavenly sanctuary that he might now appear before God on our behalf.

His death on the cross is his sacrifice of love through which we have been redeemed from death. Now, he ascends to heaven and appears before the Father to intercede on our behalf. And because his priesthood lasts forever, "he is always able to save those who approach God through him, since he lives forever to make intercession for them" (Hebrews 7:25). And so, each time we gather to celebrate the Holy Eucharist, we are essentially participating in the one eternal sacrifice of Christ and approaching the Father through him.

Our opening prayer reminds us that the ascension of Christ "is our exaltation, and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope." To live in this hope is to keep our focus primarily on Christ and on heaven – for our true life is in Christ and heaven is our true home. Thus, St. Paul exhorts that because we have been raised with Christ, we should "seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory" (Colossians 3:1-4).

As we celebrate this solemnity, let us ask God to raise us from the life of sin and fill us with his grace to live in the hope of the resurrection. Amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Cristo al cielo. Cristo asciende al cielo, no para abandonarnos, sino para presentarnos ante el Padre. Tenemos dos opciones para la Segunda Lectura de hoy: una de la Carta de San Pablo a los Efesios (1,17-23) y la otra, de la Carta a los Hebreos (9,24-28; 10,19-23). La segunda opción, de la Carta a los Hebreos, nos ofrece una perspectiva cultual y litúrgica para contemplar la ascensión de Cristo. El autor declara que Cristo asciende al santuario celestial para comparecer ante Dios en nuestro nombre.

Su muerte en la cruz es su sacrificio de amor, por el cual fuimos redimidos de la muerte. Ahora, asciende al cielo y comparece ante el Padre para interceder por nosotros. Y como su sacerdocio es eterno, «puede salvar siempre a los que por él se acercan a Dios, ya que vive eternamente para interceder por ellos» (Hebreos 7:25). Así, cada vez que nos reunimos para celebrar la Sagrada Eucaristía, participamos esencialmente del único sacrificio eterno de Cristo y nos acercamos al Padre por medio de él.

Nuestra oración inicial nos recuerda que la ascensión de Cristo «es nuestra exaltación, y donde la Cabeza ha ido antes en gloria, el Cuerpo está llamado a seguirla en esperanza». Vivir en esta esperanza significa centrarnos principalmente en Cristo y en el cielo, pues nuestra verdadera vida está en Cristo y el cielo es nuestro verdadero hogar. Por eso, san Pablo exhorta a que, puesto que hemos resucitado con Cristo, «busquemos las cosas de arriba, donde Cristo está sentado a la diestra de Dios. Pensemos en las cosas de arriba, no en las de la tierra. Porque habéis muerto, y vuestra vida está escondida con Cristo en Dios. Cuando Cristo, vuestra vida, se manifieste, entonces también vosotros seréis manifestados con él en gloria» (Colosenses 3:1-4).

Al celebrar esta solemnidad, pidamos a Dios que nos libere del pecado y nos llene de su gracia para vivir en la esperanza de la resurrección. ¡Amén!

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!






OCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION




