Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy Pentecost Sunday! On this day, we meditate on the gift of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday. It is through the Holy Spirit that we are able to live as adopted sons and daughters of God, calling God *Abba Father!*

Without the Holy Spirit, we will be lifeless. Indeed, the Acts of the Apostles has often been described as the Gospel of the Holy Spirit. In it we see how through the power of the Holy Spirit, the members of the Church were able to flourish and give witness to the saving graces of God through Christ. The same is true today.

We cannot be effective disciples of Christ if we do not live by the Spirit. To live by the Spirit is to first acknowledge in gratitude that God has made us his children by giving us the Holy Spirit. And as his children, he calls us to live a life that manifests our true identity as his children.

To live by the Holy Spirit is also to surrender to the Spirit's guidance — to be docile to the Holy Spirit and not to be controlled by one's own selfish desires and impulses — often referred to as the desires of the flesh. St. Paul warns that those who are in the flesh cannot please God. This is not to say that the body is inherently evil. Rather, by "flesh" Paul was referring to sensual lust and the tendency to indulge in sinful desires. Such a lifestyle is not pleasing to God and is void of the presence of the Holy Spirit.

In his Letter to the Galatians, St. Paul contrasts the works of the flesh with the works of the Holy Spirit (see Galatians 5: 16-26). The fruits of the flesh are seen in idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, rivalry, jealousy, selfishness, orgies, etc. On the other hand, the works of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

As we celebrate Pentecost this year, let us ask ourselves this question: does my life align with the fruits of the Spirit or with the works of the flesh? Regardless of your response today, may you always trust in the grace of the Holy Spirit to heal, strengthen and transform you. Amen!

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

¡Feliz Domingo de Pentecostés! En este día, meditamos sobre el don de la efusión del Espíritu Santo en el Domingo de Pentecostés. Es a través del Espíritu Santo que podemos vivir como hijos adoptivos de Dios, llamando a Dios Abba Padre. Sin el Espíritu Santo, careceremos de vida. De hecho, los Hechos de los Apóstoles se han descrito a menudo como el Evangelio del Espíritu Santo. En él vemos cómo, mediante el poder del Espíritu Santo, los miembros de la Iglesia pudieron florecer y dar testimonio de la gracia salvadora de Dios por medio de Cristo. Lo mismo ocurre hoy.

No podemos ser discípulos eficaces de Cristo si no vivimos por el Espíritu. Vivir por el Espíritu es, ante todo, reconocer con gratitud que Dios nos ha hecho sus hijos al darnos el Espíritu Santo. Y como hijos suyos, nos llama a vivir una vida que manifieste nuestra verdadera identidad como hijos suyos. Vivir según el Espíritu Santo también significa someterse a su guía: ser dócil al Espíritu Santo y no dejarse controlar por los propios deseos e impulsos egoístas, a menudo llamados deseos de la carne. San Pablo advierte que quienes viven en la carne no pueden agradar a Dios. Esto no significa que el cuerpo sea inherentemente malo. Más bien, con «carne», Pablo se refería a la lujuria sensual y a la tendencia a entregarse a los deseos pecaminosos. Tal estilo de vida no agrada a Dios y carece de la presencia del Espíritu Santo.

En su Carta a los Gálatas, San Pablo contrasta las obras de la carne con las obras del Espíritu Santo (véase Gálatas 5:16-26). Los frutos de la carne se ven en la idolatría, la hechicería, los odios, la rivalidad, los celos, el egoísmo, las orgías, etc. Por otro lado, las obras del Espíritu son el amor, el gozo, la paz, la paciencia, la bondad, la generosidad, la fidelidad, la mansedumbre y el dominio propio.

Al celebrar Pentecostés este año, preguntémonos: ¿Mi vida se alinea con los frutos del Espíritu o con las obras de la carne? Sea cual sea tu respuesta hoy, confía siempre en la gracia del Espíritu Santo para sanarte, fortalecerte y transformarte. ¡Amén!

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!
