Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today we celebrate the principal solemnity of our faith – the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Most Holy Trinity is the central truth and reality of life. God is the ground of existence, and it is in Him that "we live and move and have our being!" (See Acts 17:28).

Today's celebration is about the "inner" (hidden) life of God, and it plumbs the depths of the mystery of who God is. As humans, we are incapable of knowing and understanding the totality of the mystery of God. Yet, in his love for us, God has revealed himself to us through his only begotten Son, Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. Through Christ, we have come to see that God is Trinity — Father, Son and Holy Spirit, distinct but equal in their divinity.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is also about the nature of the relationship between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Love is about the strongest word we can use to describe this. The Father loves the Son eternally and gives himself completely to the Son; the Son returns his love eternally to the Father; and the love they share is the Holy Spirit. God is love and he has made us in his nature. We are called to live in relationship and ultimately to share in the life of God.

In the economy of salvation, the Father is revealed to us by the Son, Whom he sent in love to redeem us (John 3:16-17); the Son was incarnate by the power of the Holy Spirit and was born in time of the Blessed Virgin Mary for our redemption and salvation (Luke 1:26-35; 2:1-14; and Galatians 4:4-6); and the Holy Spirit was sent by the Father and the Son to give us new life, strengthening us in the work of salvation.

Made in love by Love for Love, let us pray in thanksgiving to God for today's solemnity as we say: Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever, Amen!

On a different note, our beloved Fr. Jacob has been assigned as the new pastor and administrator of St. Rose of Lima parish in Houston, effective July 1. Fr. J Serrato will be taking his place as our new parochial vicar (see **page 11** for a short autobiography of Fr. J). As we bid Fr. Jacob farewell and welcome Fr. J, let us keep them both in our prayers that the Good Lord will bless their ministries.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Hoy celebramos la principal solemnidad de nuestra fe: la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. La Santísima Trinidad es la verdad y realidad central de la vida. Dios es la base de la existencia, y es en Él que «vivimos, nos movemos y existimos» (Hechos 17:28).

La celebración de hoy trata sobre la vida «interior» (oculta) de Dios y profundiza en el misterio de quién es Dios. Como humanos, somos incapaces de conocer y comprender la totalidad del misterio de Dios. Sin embargo, en su amor por nosotros, Dios se nos ha revelado a través de su Hijo unigénito, Jesucristo, nuestro Señor y Salvador. A través de Cristo, hemos llegado a comprender que Dios es Trinidad: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, distintos pero iguales en su divinidad.

Around the Parish

Hi, my name is Fr. J Serrato. My place of origin is Mexico. I come from a prolific couple, to say the least. I'm a cradle Catholic. At a very young age, I was voluntold by my mother to become an altar server. God has a sense of humor. This, perhaps insignificant ministry of serving at the altar, sparked my "curiosity" for the priesthood. Oblivious of the nature of the priesthood, namely, that a catholic priest never gets married, must go through a lengthy formation, and promises obedience to his bishop, I began to tell myself that one day I will be a priest. Evidently, this was a very immature idea. Yet, at a certain point, this curiosity became more than just an idea. It became a desire. I wanted to be like the parish priest I was assisting at the Masses.

However, as I got older, I began to open my eyes. Like every young adult, I wanted to explore and live in my own world. In other words, I intentionally repressed God's calling to the priesthood. I wanted to be like the rest of my friends. I wanted to fit in the circle, be popular at school, date, and be



"free" like many of them. I attended public schools most of my life, where I played different sports. I had it all, yet, I had nothing. The world promised me everything but gave me nothing. My heart was restless, as St. Augustine tells us in his *Confessions*. I went out seeking for happiness, yet soon I realized that all I had to do was to look inside of myself. Throughout my years of High School, I was experiencing a spiritual headache, I wasn't sure what God wanted me to do. On the one hand, my family was showing me the good side of God by attending church faithfully, but on the other hand, my friends were showing me the temptations of the world. Consequently, I began to seek help by praying and reaching out to other priests, and by attending retreats. I knew that I needed spiritual guidance in my discernment.

Soon after I started seeking help, with the grace of God, I concluded that God was calling me to the priesthood. To be frank, I was surprised because, like I mentioned above, I desperately wanted to be part of the circle. Such were my ignorance and arrogance, that I told God what I wanted to do with my life. Today that I know God a bit better, per se, I can say that He probably laughed at me. The "aha" moment in my life was when I approached God from a different perspective. I turned the question around. I knew it was risky. It was like handing a blank check to God. I asked God: **what do you** want me to do with my life? **Be a priest!** That was His answer. **Do you recall when you were a child? I made you to become a priest. I have always been with you.** This encounter with the Lord changed everything. I dropped off everything and with many questions, insecurity and fear, I began to follow the Lord. Once I was accepted as a seminarian by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston, I was sent to St. Joseph's Seminary in Covington, Louisiana where I studied philosophy. After graduating from St. Joseph's, I moved back to St. Mary's Seminary in Houston to finish my theological studies. By the grace of God, I was ordained a priest of Jesus Christ by Cardinal Daniel DiNardo on June 3rd of 2023 at the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, in Houston.

During the last two years of my priesthood, I have been serving as a parochial vicar of Sacred Heart in Manvel and as chaplain for the AYC (Archdiocesan Youth Conference). Today, with much hope and joy I embark on a new assignment in this local island of Galveston. Undoubtedly, this is part of God's will for me in my priestly ministry. Hence, I humble ask that you keep me in your prayers. From my part, be assured of my prayers for you.






