Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today we celebrate the solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the two great pillars and Apostles of our faith. To Peter, our Savior entrusted what is now known as the Petrine Ministry—the succession of popes throughout the ages who continue Peter's ministry of serving as the Vicar of Christ on earth and a sign of unity for all believers.

And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

These words of Christ are addressed not only to Peter, but through him to the Church, to whom Christ has entrusted the work of redemption. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are sent forth with His same mission: As the Father has sent me, so I send you!

St. Paul's vocation as an apostle began in the most unexpected ways. Once a fierce persecutor of the Church, he was transformed by the mercy of God and called to proclaim the very Name he sought to extinguish. In humble gratitude, he wrote: "Last of all, as to one born abnormally, he [Christ] appeared to me. For I am the least of the Apostles, not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God" (1 Corinthians 15:8-9).

Like Saints Peter and Paul, we each share in the apostolic mission to proclaim the Gospel of salvation – not only by our words but even more so by the witness of our lives. Every disciple of Christ has received gifts through the Holy Spirit, and we are called to use them in building up the Body of Christ and announcing his saving love to all. With St. Paul, may we echo this confession: "But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me has not been ineffective. Indeed, I have toiled harder than all of them; not I, however, but the grace of God [that is] within me" (1 Corinthians 15:10].

On this feast day, St. Augustine invites us to "love their faith, their lives, their labors, their sufferings, their confession of faith, their preaching."

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Hoy celebramos la solemnidad de los santos Pedro y Pablo, dos grandes pilares y apóstoles de nuestra fe. A Pedro, nuestro Salvador, le confió lo que hoy se conoce como el Ministerio Petrino: la sucesión de papas a lo largo de los siglos que continúan el ministerio de Pedro, sirviendo como Vicario de Cristo en la tierra y signo de unidad para todos los creyentes.

Estas palabras de Cristo se dirigen no solo a Pedro, sino a través de él a la Iglesia, a quien Cristo ha confiado la obra de la redención. Impulsados por el Espíritu Santo, somos enviados con su misma misión: ¡Como el Padre me envió, así también yo os envío!

La vocación de San Pablo como apóstol comenzó de las maneras más inesperadas. Antaño feroz perseguidor de la Iglesia, fue transformado por la misericordia de Dios y llamado a proclamar el mismo Nombre que buscaba extinguir. Con humilde gratitud, escribió: "Y al último, como a un nacido anormal, se me apareció a mí. Pues yo soy el más pequeño de los apóstoles, no digno de ser llamado apóstol, porque perseguí a la iglesia de Dios" (1 Corintios 15:8-9).

Al igual que los santos Pedro y Pablo, todos compartimos la misión apostólica de proclamar el Evangelio de la salvación, no solo con nuestras palabras, sino aún más con el testimonio de nuestras vidas. Todo discípulo de Cristo ha recibido dones por medio del Espíritu Santo, y estamos llamados a usarlos para edificar el Cuerpo de Cristo y anunciar su amor salvador a todos. Con San Pablo, hagamos eco de esta confesión: «Pero por la gracia de Dios soy lo que soy, y su gracia para conmigo no ha sido en vano. Al contrario, he trabajado más que todos ellos; pero no yo, sino la gracia de Dios que está en mí» (1 Corintios 15:10).

En esta festividad, San Agustín nos invita a "amar su fe, su vida, sus trabajos, sus sufrimientos, su confesión de fe, su predicación".

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!




OCIA and Adult Confirmation






