Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Our Gospel reading today invites us to reflect on our vocations as Christians—and, in particular, on the call to the priesthood. Just as Christ sent out His disciples to proclaim the Good News, so too does He send each of us. Are you intentionally living out your vocation as a disciple of Christ? Do you encourage vocations in your home, especially to the priesthood?

Later during this Mass, the priest will present the Vocations Cross to a family or individual, who will commit to praying for an increase in holy vocations to the priesthood and religious life. This is our community's response to the Lord's invitation: "ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." We are deeply grateful to all who have participated in this prayer ministry. However, more parishioners are needed to join us in this vital work. If you have not yet signed up to take the Vocations Cross, please consider doing so—with your family, with friends, or on your own—as a way of supporting vocations in our Church.

To the young men present or reading this today: Have you considered that God may be calling you to the priesthood? Perhaps **you** are an answer to our prayers for holy vocations. The good news is, you don't have to figure it all out on your own. From **July 18–20**, there will be a **Discernment Retreat** for young men ages 18–35. Signing up is simple—just visit **HoustonVocations.com** for more details. (This website also offers excellent resources for both men and women discerning a religious vocation.)

If you are not ready for a retreat but would like to speak to someone about what God might be calling you to, that's more than okay. I would be honored to meet with you to listen prayerfully for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in your journey. 




OCIA AND ADULT CONTINUING FAITH FORMATION


