### Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Growing up in Nigeria, West Africa, it was common for children to receive life's important lessons through storytelling. I still remember many of those stories, and as I grew older, I came to understand why they were such powerful teaching tools: it's difficult to forget the lessons wrapped in a story. If the story stays with you, so does the wisdom it carries.

The same is true of today's Gospel—the parable of the Good Samaritan. The scholar who approached Jesus seemed confident in his righteousness. To justify himself, he asked, "And who is my neighbor?" Notice how Jesus, after telling the story of the Good Samaritan, turns the question around: who was neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers? "The one who treated him with mercy," the scholar replies.

In this story, Jesus breaks down boundaries and expands our understanding of who neighbor is. A neighbor is not just someone who shares our location—but anyone to whom we extend **mercy and charity**.

Many of us truly wish to be good neighbors, especially to those who are suffering, yet fear or hesitation often hold us back. Stopping by the roadside to help someone with car trouble at night may not always be safe. Still, there are ways we can respond: for example, calling the proper authorities to ensure the person receives help. Small acts of compassion can go a long way.

To be a neighbor, like the Good Samaritan, requires sacrifice. He stopped, attended to the wounded man, and even provided for his continued care—at personal cost. Let us not be too hurried to notice the needs around us. Instead, let us see our blessings as resources entrusted to us by God to serve others.

I leave you with a quote often attributed to St. Francis of Assisi: "Remember that when you leave this earth, you can take with you nothing that you have received—only what you have given: a full heart, enriched by honest service, love, sacrifice, and courage."

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

### Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Al crecer en Nigeria, África Occidental, era común que los niños aprendieran lecciones importantes de la vida a través de historias. Todavía recuerdo muchas de esas historias, y al crecer, comprendí por qué eran herramientas de enseñanza tan poderosas: es difícil olvidar las lecciones que encierra una historia. Si la historia se queda grabada en tu memoria, también lo hace la sabiduría que transmite.

Lo mismo ocurre con el Evangelio de hoy la parábola del Buen Samaritano. El erudito que se acercó a Jesús parecía confiar en su justicia. Para justificarse, preguntó: "¿Y quién es mi prójimo?". Observe cómo Jesús, después de contar la historia del Buen Samaritano, le da la vuelta a la pregunta: ¿quién fue el prójimo del hombre que cayó en manos de ladrones? "El que lo trató con misericordia", responde el erudito.

En esta historia, Jesús rompe barreras y amplía nuestra comprensión de quién es el prójimo. Un prójimo no es solo alguien que comparte nuestra ubicación, sino cualquier persona a quien mostramos misericordia y caridad.

Muchos de nosotros realmente deseamos ser buenos vecinos, especialmente con quienes sufren, pero el miedo o la indecisión a menudo nos frenan. Parar en la carretera para ayudar a alguien con problemas con el coche por la noche no siempre es seguro. Aun así, hay maneras de responder: por ejemplo, llamar a las autoridades competentes para asegurar que la persona reciba ayuda. Pequeños actos de compasión pueden ser muy útiles.

Ser vecino, como el Buen Samaritano, requiere sacrificio. Se detuvo, atendió al hombre herido e incluso se encargó de su cuidado continuo, a costa de su propio esfuerzo. No nos apresuremos a reconocer las necesidades que nos rodean. En cambio, veamos nuestras bendiciones como recursos que Dios nos ha confiado para servir a los demás.

Les dejo con una cita que a menudo se atribuye a San Francisco de Asís: "Recuerda que cuando dejes esta tierra, no te llevarás nada de lo que has recibido, solo lo que has dado: un corazón pleno, enriquecido por el servicio honesto, el amor, el sacrificio y la valentía".

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!
