## Message from the Pastor

Mensaje del Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Hospitality is a sacred thread woven throughout human relationships. The word itself comes from the Latin *hospitalitas*, meaning "friendliness to guests." Today's First Reading and Gospel offer us profound insights into the spiritual dimension of hospitality.

In the First Reading, Abraham welcomes three strangers who turn out to be angels. Later, the Letter to the Hebrews recalls this encounter, urging us: "Do not neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained angels." Like Abraham, we receive blessings when we open our hearts to strangers, especially those on the margins.

In the Gospel, we meet Martha and Mary, who each show hospitality in their own way. Martha busies herself with service, tending to Christ's needs, much like Abraham did initially. Mary, on the other hand, offers Jesus her full and undivided attention. Both expressions are valid and meaningful, but Jesus affirms Mary's choice to be present. It reminds us that while service is important, true hospitality ultimately invites others to feel seen, valued, and dignified.

Hospitality, then, isn't just about doing; it's about being. It's about cultivating a loving presence that reflects the welcome of heaven itself. Mary gives us a glimpse of that heavenly hospitality, where freed from anxiety and distraction, we are drawn into the joy of simply abiding with God.

As the Psalmist says: *"Better one day in your courts, O Lord, than a thousand elsewhere"* (See Psalm 84:11). Mary chose that "better part," and we are all invited to do the same.

So let us extend our hospitality not only to those around us, but to God—especially in prayer. May we meet Him not only with our litany of requests but with quiet reverence, resting in His presence.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

#### **Queridos en Cristo:**

La hospitalidad es un valor sagrado profundamente entretejido en nuestras relaciones humanas. La palabra proviene del latín *hospitalitas*, que significa "amabilidad hacia los huéspedes." Las lecturas de hoy, tanto del Antiguo Testamento como del Evangelio, nos ofrecen una profunda enseñanza sobre la dimensión espiritual de la hospitalidad.

En la primera lectura, Abraham recibe a tres desconocidos que, más adelante, se revelan como ángeles. Esta escena es recordada también en la Carta a los Hebreos, cuando se nos exhorta: "No se olviden de la hospitalidad, pues por ella algunos, sin saberlo, hospedaron ángeles." Como Abraham, también nosotros somos bendecidos cuando abrimos el corazón a los forasteros, especialmente a quienes están en los márgenes de la sociedad.

En el Evangelio, vemos a Marta y María que ofrecen hospitalidad de maneras distintas. Marta se dedica al servicio, atendiendo las necesidades de Jesús, al igual que Abraham en su momento. María, en cambio, se entrega a una atención plena y amorosa, sentándose a los pies del Señor. Ambas expresiones son valiosas, pero Jesús destaca que María ha elegido "la mejor parte." Esto nos recuerda que, aunque el servicio es importante, la hospitalidad plena también se manifiesta en una presencia atenta que haga sentir al otro visto, valorado y amado.

La verdadera hospitalidad no es solo hacer, sino estar. No es simplemente servir con las manos, sino también abrir el corazón. María nos da un anticipo de la hospitalidad celestial, donde, libres de ansiedades, nos entregamos a la contemplación gozosa de Dios.

Como dice el salmista: *"Vale más un solo día en tus atrios, Señor, que mil en otra parte."* Esa es la mejor parte que María escogió y a la cual todos estamos llamados a aspirar.

Que también nosotros sepamos ofrecer hospitalidad al mismo Dios, sobre todo en la oración, no solo para presentarle nuestras necesidades, sino para simplemente descansar en su presencia.

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!




