Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

In today's Gospel Reading, Jesus teaches us the value of *persistent prayer*. He doesn't begin with a lecture or a parable—He begins with action. His disciples notice this and are inspired: "Lord, teach us to pray." Christ doesn't just pray occasionally—He continues to intercede for us. As the Letter to the Hebrews affirms, "*He lives forever to make intercession for those who approach God through him*" (Hebrews 7:25).

Prayer is essential to the life of every disciple. Throughout the history of salvation, you won't find a saint who lacked a deep and consistent prayer life. Prayer is more than a request for divine assistance—it is the sacred space where we enter into communion with the living God.

True prayer begins by recognizing all that we've already received in Christ. The Holy Spirit draws us deeper into God's own life. That's why, in today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us: "*If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?*"

God knows what we truly need. While we certainly face daily and temporal concerns, God invites us to desire what is eternal—a share in His divine life. When we pray in the Spirit, our desires align with God's will (see Romans 8:26–27), and our hearts become more deeply attuned to His.

So when Jesus tells us to "ask," "seek," and "knock," it's not just about persistence in petition. It's an invitation to grow in our trust of a generous Father whose plans far exceed anything we could ask or imagine (Ephesians 3:20).

How is your prayer life? Do you set aside time for God each day? Do you pray together as a family? Why not begin today? Let your time in prayer be a taste of eternity—a moment of practicing heaven.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos en Cristo:

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos enseña el valor de la *oración perseverante*. No comienza con una explicación teórica, sino con el ejemplo: se pone a orar. Sus discípulos, al verlo, se sienten inspirados y le piden: "Señor, enséñanos a orar." Cristo no solo oró en vida, sino que continúa intercediendo por nosotros. Como dice la Carta a los Hebreos: "*Vive para interceder por los que se acercan a Dios por medio de Él*" (Hebreos 7, 25). La oración es esencial en la vida de todo discípulo. A lo largo de la historia de la salvación, no encontramos ningún santo o santa que no haya tenido una vida de oración profunda y constante. Orar no es solamente pedir cosas; es entrar en comunión con el Dios vivo.

La verdadera oración comienza con el reconocimiento de todo lo que ya hemos recibido en Cristo. El Espíritu Santo nos introduce en la vida misma de Dios. Por eso, Jesús dice hoy: "*Si ustedes, que son malos, saben dar cosas buenas a sus hijos, ¡cuánto más el Padre del cielo dará el Espíritu Santo a los que se lo pidan!*"

Dios conoce nuestras verdaderas necesidades. Aunque vivimos preocupados por necesidades temporales, el Señor quiere darnos aquello que permanece: una participación en su vida eterna. Por eso, cuando oramos guiados por el Espíritu, nuestros deseos se alinean con la voluntad de Dios (cf. Romanos 8, 26–27).

Cuando Jesús nos dice: "pidan", "busquen" y "llamen", no se trata solo de insistir, sino de aprender a desear lo que Dios desea para nosotros. Porque lo que el Padre tiene preparado para nosotros supera por mucho lo que podríamos imaginar (cf. Efesios 3, 20).

¿Cómo está tu vida de oración? ¿Te haces un espacio para Dios cada día? ¿Oras en familia? Hoy puede ser un buen momento para comenzar. Piensa en la oración como un entrenamiento para el cielo—una oportunidad de practicar la eternidad.

Somos: **una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!**
