Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today's First Reading raises a fundamental question about the value of human toil and the quest for meaning: "For what profit comes to man from all the toil and anxiety of heart with which he has labored under the sun?", asks Qoheleth, the sage in Ecclesiastes.

Christ offers us a clear answer in today's Gospel. Human labor finds true fulfillment when it gives glory to God through the service of our brothers and sisters. God, as our Loving Father, created us and entrusted us with stewardship over the world. He invites us to use its resources well and contribute to its flourishing through our own efforts.

The riches of the world were never meant for selfish indulgence. To live with a mindset solely fixed on acquiring wealth for personal enjoyment is to walk in the foolishness of the rich man in today's Gospel. His story stands as a warning to those who "are not rich in what matters to God," namely, the riches of charity.

As disciples of Christ, we must not lose sight of our heavenly call. St. Paul exhorts us in the Second Reading to keep our gaze fixed on Christ by seeking what is above—what is of heaven. We do this by putting to death those earthly desires that distance us from God: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, **and the greed that is idolatry.**

This week's readings remind us that our hearts are truly restless until they rest in God. If our pursuits are rooted in selfish gain, they will ultimately leave us empty. But when our work and resources are directed toward eternal goods—love, generosity, communion—we find lasting joy.

Let us ask for the grace to be "rich in what matters to God." May our lives reflect a wisdom that sees beyond earthly success to the treasures of Christ himself. In giving generously, in loving sincerely, and in seeking God faithfully, we build a harvest that endures.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos hermanos en Cristo:

La Primera Lectura de hoy plantea una pregunta fundamental sobre el valor del esfuerzo humano y la búsqueda de sentido: "¿Qué provecho saca el hombre de todos sus afanes y preocupaciones bajo el sol?", pregunta Qohelet, el sabio del libro de Eclesiastés.

Cristo nos ofrece una respuesta clara en el Evangelio de hoy. El trabajo humano encuentra su verdadero cumplimiento cuando da gloria a Dios mediante el servicio a nuestros hermanos. Dios, como Padre amoroso, nos creó y nos confió el cuidado del mundo. Nos invita a usar bien sus recursos y a contribuir a su florecimiento con nuestras propias obras.

Las riquezas del mundo no fueron destinadas al gozo egoísta. Vivir con la mente puesta únicamente en acumular bienes para el disfrute personal es seguir la necedad del hombre rico del Evangelio. Su historia es una advertencia para aquellos que "no son ricos en lo que importa a Dios", es decir, en las riquezas de la caridad.

Como discípulos de Cristo, no debemos perder de vista nuestra vocación celestial. San Pablo nos exhorta en la Segunda Lectura a mantener la mirada fija en Cristo, buscando las cosas de arriba —lo que es del cielo. Lo hacemos al dar muerte a los deseos terrenales que nos alejan de Dios: la inmoralidad, la impureza, las pasiones desordenadas, el mal deseo y la **codicia, que es una forma de idolatría.**

Las lecturas de esta semana nos recuerdan que nuestros corazones sólo descansan verdaderamente cuando descansan en Dios. Si nuestras metas nacen del egoísmo, al final nos dejarán vacíos. Pero cuando nuestro trabajo y nuestros recursos se orientan hacia los bienes eternos—el amor, la generosidad, la comunión—encontramos una alegría duradera.

Pidamos la gracia de ser "ricos en lo que importa a Dios." Que nuestra vida refleje la sabiduría que mira más allá del éxito terrenal hacia el tesoro que es Cristo mismo. Al dar con generosidad, al amar con sinceridad y al buscar a Dios con fidelidad, cosechamos una abundancia que perdura.

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!
