#### Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today's Gospel reading begins with these lovely words from Christ: "Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom." Take a moment to let those words sink in. God is pleased to give us the kingdom. God desires us to be with Him in heaven, where there will be no more death? Do you believe?

Faith is required to accept this promise of God. If we took a moment to imagine heaven and all that it entails, many of us might entertain some doubt about its attainment. A place of no sorrow, no more wars or death, where the day is eternal and only good abides, with no room for worry—it is simply indescribable!

Yet, that is the destiny that God has in store for all His faithful children. But we need faith to accept His gift. "Faith," we are told in today's Second Reading, "is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen." We hope for and believe in what we are yet to see and experience; for what is seen leads to knowledge, not faith.

We are blessed, therefore, if we believe without having seen: "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed" (John 20:29). This beatitude of Jesus is addressed to all those who have faith in the promises of God. But faith without good works is dead! (See James 2:14-—18) Our faith must be made manifest through our actions.

Christ makes the same emphasis in today's Gospel Reading: Be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks. Blessed are those servants whom the master finds vigilant on his arrival. [...] Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more."

God has entrusted us with the promise of everlasting life—do you believe in this promise? Remember, you are already responding to this crucial question by the way you are conducting yourself.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

#### Mensaje del Pastor

#### **Queridos hermanos en Cristo:**

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy comienza con estas hermosas palabras de Cristo: "No temas, pequeño rebaño, porque el Padre ha querido darte el Reino." Tómese un momento para dejar que esas palabras penetren en su corazón. Dios se complace en darnos el Reino. Dios desea que estemos con Él en el cielo, donde ya no habrá muerte. ¿Lo cree usted?

Se necesita fe para aceptar esta promesa de Dios. Si nos detuviéramos a imaginar el cielo y todo lo que implica, muchos podríamos tener dudas sobre alcanzarlo. Un lugar sin tristeza, sin guerras ni muerte, donde el día es eterno y sólo habita el bien, sin espacio para la preocupación—jes simplemente indescriptible!

Sin embargo, ese es el destino que Dios tiene reservado para todos sus hijos fieles. Pero necesitamos fe para aceptar su regalo. En la Segunda Lectura de hoy se nos dice: "La fe es garantía de lo que se espera, la prueba de lo que no se ve." Esperamos y creemos en lo que aún no hemos visto ni experimentado; porque lo que se ve conduce al conocimiento, no a la fe.

Somos bendecidos, entonces, si creemos sin haber visto: "Dichosos los que creen sin haber visto" (Juan 20:29). Esta bienaventuranza de Jesús está dirigida a todos los que tienen fe en las promesas de Dios. Pero la fe sin obras está muerta (ver Santiago 2:14–18). Nuestra fe debe manifestarse a través de nuestras acciones.

Cristo hace el mismo énfasis en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy: "Sean como los criados que están esperando a que su señor regrese de una boda, listos para abrirle en cuanto llegue y llame. Dichosos aquellos criados a quienes su señor, al llegar, los encuentre vigilantes. [...] Al que mucho se le dio, mucho se le exigirá; y al que mucho se le confió, más se le pedirá."

Dios nos ha confiado la promesa de la vida eterna—¿cree usted en esta promesa? Recuerde que ya está respondiendo a esta pregunta crucial por la manera en que se comporta.

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!






