Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Jesus describes the kingdom of God as the great ingathering of God's people from every corner of the earth: "And people will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and will recline at table in the kingdom of God. For behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last."

As faithful disciples, we are called to serve as **bridges** to God's kingdom. That is, we are to embody Christ's love, mercy, and truth in the world—becoming living conduits of grace. Through acts of compassion, justice, and reconciliation, we are to help others encounter the divine presence in everyday life. It truly was a blessing to be there with your parishioners, your upbeat beautiful soulful music and your heartfelt homily. Once again God has proven that he is Awesome. God is Good and God was present at Holy Mass at Holy Rosary on Sunday. Keep up the good work. I have not made it to the Holy Land of Israel yet, but I have been to the Holy Land of Galveston-Houston."

May we continue to serve as bridges to God's kingdom in our parish—helping all who enter our doors to encounter the love of God and the joy of Christian community.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Aún no he llegado a Tierra Santa en Israel, pero sí he estado en la Tierra Santa de Galveston-Houston."




