## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Prudence is one of the four cardinal virtues. It helps us to make the right choice in every circumstance in which we find ourselves. Thus, St. Thomas defines it as “right reason in action.” Without prudence, we run the risk of being indecisive, always doubting ourselves. Prudence, therefore, can be seen as the *charioteer of the virtues*, because it helps us to apply all the other virtues appropriately. For this reason, Josef Pieper observes that “the wise person is also a prudent person.” And we can say the same thing about the person who is good, moderate, humble, and so forth.

Our Readings today invite us to examine ourselves in the light of this virtue. Christ’s parable in today’s Gospel, inviting us to keep in mind the weightier matters in life, is really an invitation to prudence. A faithful disciple is one who, guided by prudence and animated with the love of God examines the cost and reward of following Christ faithfully. Yes, discipleship involves sacrifice that is, the cross—but the rewards are *out of this world!*

Here’s another way to examine the words of Christ in today’s Gospel. If God is God, and God is God, it means God is supreme above all, and nothing is, nor shall be, impossible for God. Preferring God and the things of God above everything and everyone else, therefore, is the prudent thing to do, because one who is truly possessed by God—and not by material, transitory things and realities—has it all.

“Who can know God’s counsel, or who can conceive what the Lord intends?” Christ is the answer to this introductory question in today’s First Reading. He has fully revealed to us God’s will for our salvation. In response, let us be like those prudent stewards that Christ speaks about in Luke 12:35–40. A prudent steward vigilantly waits for the Lord not with anxiety, but with quiet, exultant joy knowing that the Lord rewards fidelity.

As we journey together in faith, may we grow in the virtue of prudence choosing what is good, true, and eternal. Let us encourage one another to prefer the things of God, to carry our crosses with hope, to live as joyful stewards of the Gospel. In doing so, we become not only wise, but truly free.

We are: **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

## Mensaje del Pastor

**Queridos hermanos en Cristo:**

La prudencia es una de las cuatro virtudes cardinales. Nos ayuda a tomar la decisión correcta en cada circunstancia en la que nos encontremos. Por eso, Santo Tomás la define como “la recta razón en acción.” Sin prudencia, corremos el riesgo de ser indecisos, dudando constantemente de nosotros mismos. La prudencia, entonces, puede considerarse como el auriga de las virtudes, porque nos permite aplicar correctamente todas las demás. Por esta razón, Josef Pieper observa que “la persona sabia también es una persona prudente.” Y podemos decir lo mismo de quien es bueno, moderado, humilde, y así sucesivamente.

Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a examinarnos a la luz de esta virtud. La parábola de Cristo en el Evangelio de hoy, que nos llama a considerar los asuntos más importantes de la vida, es realmente una invitación a la prudencia. Un discípulo fiel es aquel que, guiado por la prudencia y animado por el amor de Dios examina el costo y la recompensa de seguir a Cristo con fidelidad. Sí, el discipulado implica sacrificio es decir, la cruz pero las recompensas son fuera de este mundo!

Aquí hay otra forma de considerar las palabras de Cristo en el Evangelio de hoy. Si Dios es Dios, y Dios es Dios, significa que Dios es supremo sobre todo, y nada es ni será imposible para Él. Preferir a Dios y las cosas de Dios por encima de todo y de todos, entonces, es lo más prudente, porque quien está verdaderamente poseído por Dios y no por cosas materiales y pasajeras lo tiene todo.

“¿Quién puede conocer el designio de Dios, o quién puede imaginar lo que el Señor quiere?” Cristo es la respuesta a esta pregunta introductoria de la Primera Lectura de hoy. Él nos ha revelado plenamente la voluntad de Dios para nuestra salvación. En respuesta, seamos como esos siervos prudentes de los que habla Cristo en Lucas 12, 35–40. Un siervo prudente espera al Señor con vigilancia no con ansiedad, sino con una alegría serena y exultante sabiendo que el Señor recompensa la fidelidad.

Mientras caminamos juntos en la fe, que crezcamos en la virtud de la prudencia eligiendo lo que es bueno, verdadero y eterno. Animémonos mutuamente a preferir las cosas de Dios, a cargar nuestras cruces con esperanza, y a vivir como siervos gozosos del Evangelio. Al hacerlo, no solo seremos sabios, sino verdaderamente libres.

Somos: **una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. ¡Amén!**

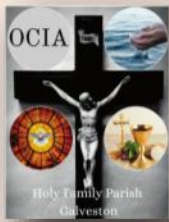
