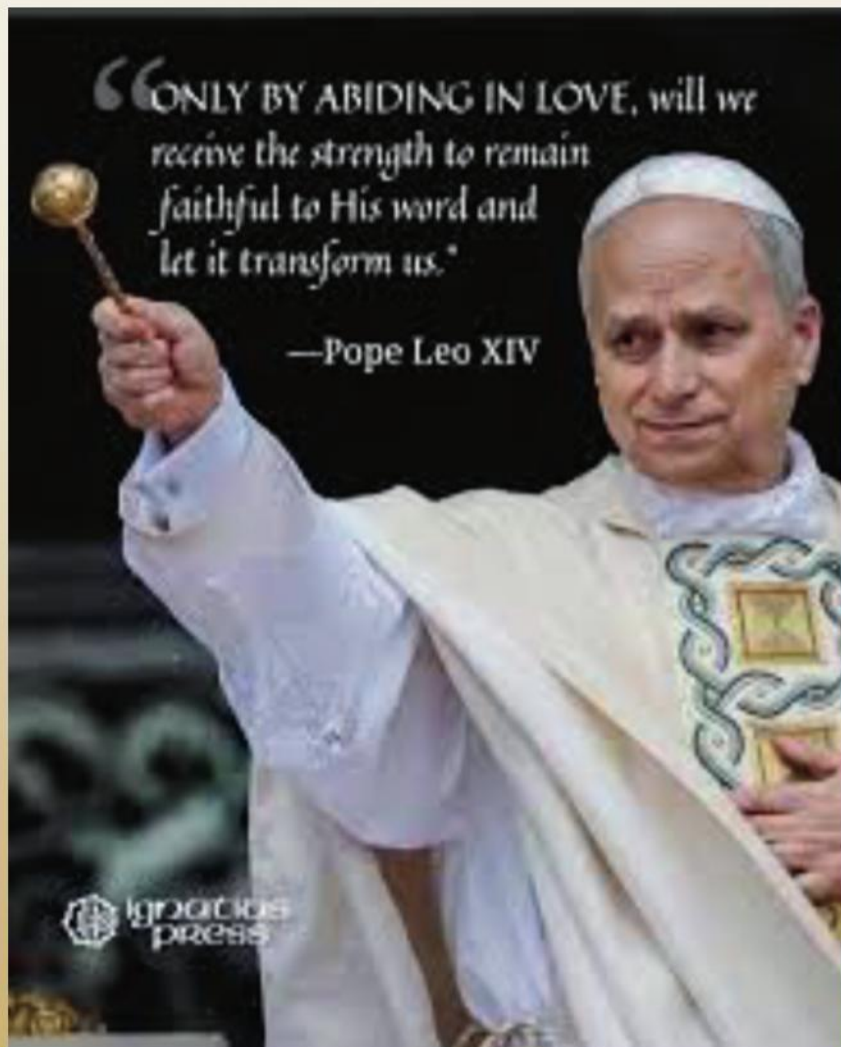




OCIA and Adult Confirmation

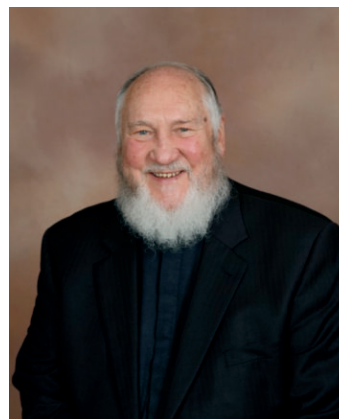
