Autobiography of Sr. Solange

My name is Sister Solange Ifunanya Uzoigwe, HHCJ, a member of the Congregation of the Handmaids of the Holy Child Jesus from Nigeria. I was born in Bamenda, Cameroon, and I am the sixth of nine children in my family.

My true calling has always been the religious life. For me, becoming a nun was the most fulfilling way to maintain a close relationship with God. The idea of living in communion with Christ in the Eucharist fills me with immense joy. My faith journey has been deeply influenced by my commitment to spiritual growth through reading, Catholic education, and meaningful experiences in both the convent and the church. From a young age, I sought to deepen my relationship with God, and I was fortunate to attend a Catholic high school, which further nurtured my knowledge and love of God. I joined the Congregation of the Handmaids of the Holy Child Jesus in 2017, and I made my first profession in 2021.



I hold a degree in chemistry from a Nigerian state university. Following my profession, I took on the roles of a chemistry teacher and catechetical instructor at Handmaids of the Holy Child middle and high school in Amumara, Nigeria, where I prepared students for the sacraments of Christian Initiation. In 2023, I seized the opportunity to deepen my theological knowledge, earning an MPhil in Christian Theology from the Loyola Institute at Trinity College Dublin. I am committed to continuously strengthening my Christian faith and constantly seeking to understand the teachings of the Church.

Currently, I serve as the Coordinator of Child Catechesis and Evangelization at Holy Family Parish, Galveston. I aspire to make a meaningful impact in my ministry among children, making the worship of God engaging and inviting for all. I aim to welcome everyone with a smile and inspire our children to serve the Lord joyfully. I find fulfillment, happiness, and peace in my vocation, knowing I am living my purpose, and I am proud to have said yes to God.
