Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate two important feast days: the Solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls). We have published the complete Mass Schedule for both celebrations in this weekend's bulletin for your review.

Both celebrations are inherently eschatological in that they call our attention to what lies beyond life on earth. As disciples of Christ who believe in the Resurrection, we look forward to living for all eternity with our Heavenly Father in the company of the Son, the Holy Spirit, the angels and all the saints.

As we celebrate All Saints Day and All Souls Day, the Church invites us to reflect on the profound mystery of the communion of saints—a spiritual union that binds together all members of the Body of Christ across time and eternity. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (cf. §§946–962) teaches that this communion includes: The Church Militant, those of us still on pilgrimage here on earth; The Church Suffering. the faithful departed undergoing purification in purgatory; and The Church **Triumphant**, the saints in heaven who behold God face to face.

In this communion, the spiritual goods of each member such as prayers, sacrifices, and merits are shared for the benefit of all. Regarding praying for the dead, for example, paragraph §958 affirms that "Our prayer for them is capable not only of helping them, but also of making their intercession for us effective."

On All Saints Day, we rejoice in the glory of those who have gone before us in faith and now live in the fullness of divine love. On All Souls Day, we remember and pray for those still journeying toward that fullness, trusting that our prayers aid their purification and hasten their joy.

Together, these days remind us that we are never alone. We are part of a vast spiritual family one Church, united in Christ, sharing in His life and love. Let us honor this communion by praying for the dead, asking the saints to intercede for us, and striving to live lives worthy of the calling we have received.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!



The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston requires compliance with applicable laws regarding incidents of actual or suspected child abuse including abuse involving child on child conduct. Failure to report suspected physical or mental abuse or neglect of a child in Texas is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both.

PERMISSION TO MAKE A REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED OR EXPECTED. ERR ON THE SIDE OF MAKING A GOOD FAITH REPORT RATHER THAN FAILING TO DO SO.
