Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As missionary disciples, we are called not only to proclaim the Gospel but also to support one another in building lives rooted in faith, dignity, and hope. One of the most powerful ways we do this is by nurturing the education of our children—forming their minds and hearts in the love of Christ.

I write today to share an important opportunity for families in our parish and across the state of Texas. Beginning with the 2026–2027 school year, the State of Texas will launch a new initiative called the **Texas Education Freedom Accounts (TEFA)**. This program provides financial support to families seeking private education options, including enrollment in Catholic schools.

Eligible families may receive up to \$10,800 per student annually, with increased support for students with disabilities. These funds may be used for tuition, uniforms, meals, tutoring, therapies, textbooks, technology, and more.

Priority will be given to children with disabilities from low-income families, students transferring from public schools, and households earning below 500% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Applications will open **February–March 2026**, and funds will be available for the 2026–2027 school year. The program will be administered by **Odyssey**, with support from the Texas Catholic Conference of Bishops Education Department.

This initiative is a gift—an opportunity for families to choose an educational path that aligns with their values and supports the holistic formation of their children. Catholic education is not merely academic; it is spiritual, communal, and sacramental. It helps our young people grow in virtue and prepares them to live with purpose and faith.

I encourage all families to prayerfully consider the blessing of enrolling their children in our Holy Family Catholic School, especially if your child qualifies for this opportunity. Catholic education is a gift that nurtures both academic excellence and spiritual formation, rooted in the life of our parish. A partir del año escolar 2026–2027, el Estado de Texas lanzará una nueva iniciativa llamada **Texas Education Freedom Accounts (TEFA)**. Este programa ofrece apoyo financiero a las familias que buscan opciones de educación privada, incluyendo la inscripción en escuelas católicas.

Las familias elegibles podrán recibir hasta \$10,800 por estudiante al año, con apoyo adicional para estudiantes con discapacidades. Estos fondos podrán utilizarse para matrícula, uniformes, comidas, tutorías, terapias, libros de texto, tecnología y más.

Se dará prioridad a los niños con discapacidades de familias de bajos ingresos, a los estudiantes que se transfieran de escuelas públicas y a los hogares con ingresos por debajo del 500% de las pautas federales de pobreza.

Las solicitudes se abrirán entre **febrero y marzo de 2026**, y los fondos estarán disponibles para el año escolar 2026–2027. El programa será administrado por **Odyssey**, con el apoyo del Departamento de Educación de la Conferencia Católica de Obispos de Texas.

Esta iniciativa es un regalo—una oportunidad para que las familias elijan un camino educativo que esté en armonía con sus valores y apoye la formación integral de sus hijos. La educación católica no es meramente académica; es espiritual, comunitaria y sacramental. Ayuda a nuestros jóvenes a crecer en virtud y los prepara para vivir con propósito y fe.

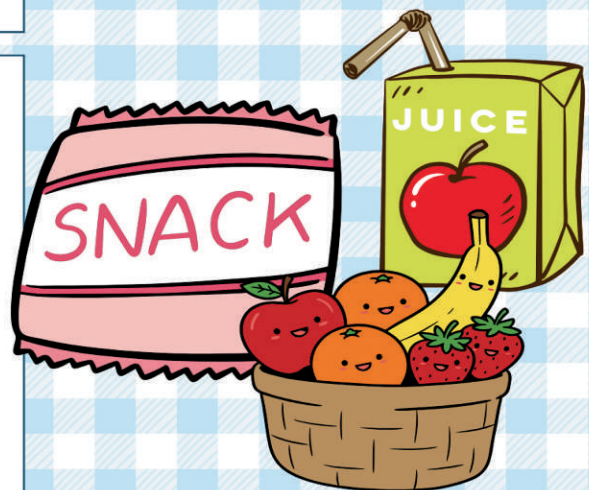

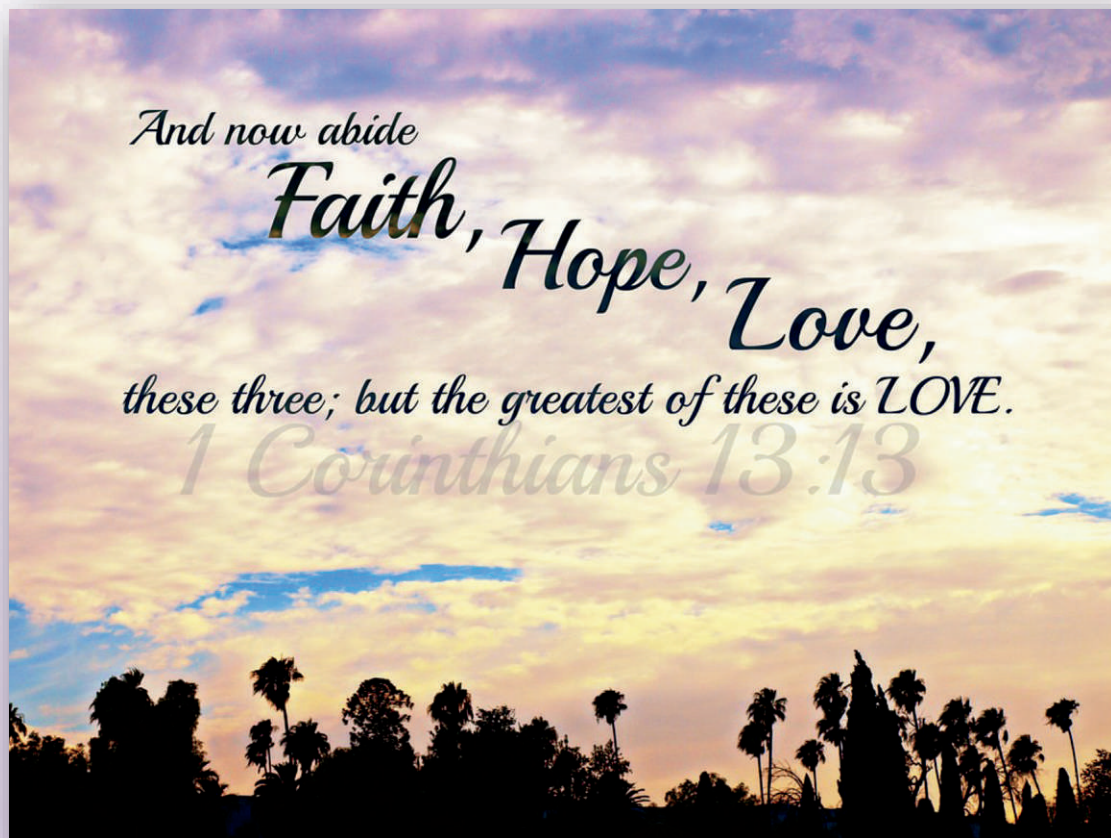

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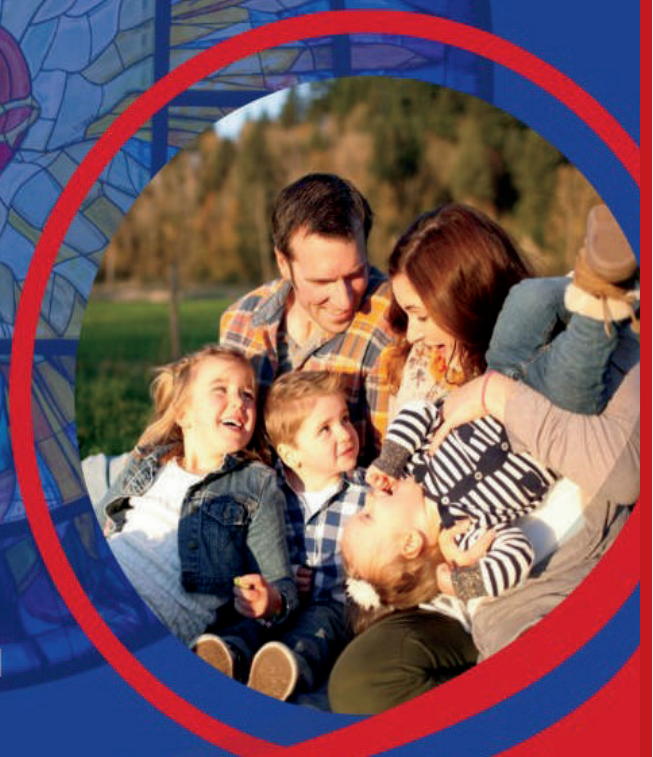
