Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This feast, which is more popularly known as "Christ the King," crowns the liturgical year and reorients our gaze toward the eternal reign of Christ. Its placement at the close of the Church's liturgical calendar is no accident: it reminds us that our earthly pilgrimage, as members of God's household, is ultimately directed toward full communion with all the saints in the kingdom of heaven.

The readings this weekend invite us to reflect on our readiness for that kingdom. Psalm 122, a psalm of ascent, evokes the joyful anticipation of pilgrims journeying toward Jerusalem, as they made their way to the temple. In the Second Reading, St. Paul exhorts us to give thanks to the Father, "who has made you fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light."

The First Reading presents David, the shepherd-king chosen by God to lead Israel. The covenant God made with David—that his throne would endure forever (2 Samuel 7:12–16)—is fulfilled in Jesus Christ, the true and eternal King. Yet in today's Gospel, we encounter a paradox: Christ reigns not from a gilded throne, but from the wood of the Cross. He is mocked, pierced, and crucified yet it is precisely here, in this moment of seeming defeat, that His kingship is most fully revealed.

The good thief, crucified beside Jesus, recognizes His hidden majesty. With humility and faith, he entrusts himself to the mercy of the Kingand receives the promise: "Today you will be with me in Paradise." This encounter reminds us that the gates of the kingdom are opened not by our personal merit, but by mercy and grace. God's mercy is lavished upon those who approach Him with a contrite heart and childlike trust.

Humility begins with the honest acknowledgment of our need for grace. Faith sustains us as we walk toward the kingdom, trusting not in our own strength, but in the love of the One who reigns and saves us from the Cross.

So, as we celebrate Christ our King, let us renew our commitment to live as citizens of His kingdom—here and now. Let us be people of mercy, forgiveness, and hope, as we serve one another with joy, build up our parish family in love, and bear witness to the reign of Christ in our community, starting in our homes.

We are: one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos hermanos en Cristo:

Este fin de semana celebramos Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo. Esta fiesta, más conocida como "Cristo Rey," corona el año litúrgico y reorienta nuestra mirada hacia el reinado eterno de Cristo. Su ubicación al final del calendario litúrgico de la Iglesia no es casual: nos recuerda que nuestra peregrinación terrenal, como miembros de la familia de Dios, está dirigida en última instancia hacia la comunión plena con todos los santos en el Reino de los cielos.

Las lecturas de este fin de semana nos invitan a reflexionar sobre nuestra preparación para ese Reino. El Salmo 122, un salmo de ascenso, evoca la alegre anticipación de los peregrinos que se dirigian a Jerusalén, mientras avanzaban hacia el templo. En la Segunda Lectura, San Pablo nos exhorta a dar gracias al Padre, "que los ha hecho aptos para participar en la herencia de los santos en la luz.

La Primera Lectura presenta a David, el pastor-rey elegido por Dios para guiar a Israel. La alianza que Dios hizo con David—que su trono perduraria para siempre (2 Samuel 7:12–16)—se cumple en Jesucristo, el verdadero y eterno Rey. Sin embargo, en el Evangelio de hoy encontramos una paradoja: Cristo no reina desde un trono dorado, sino desde la madera de la Cruz. Es burlado, herido y crucificado—y es precisamente allí, en ese momento de aparente derrota, donde su realeza se revela en plenitud.

El buen ladrón, crucificado junto a Jesús, reconoce su majestad oculta. Con humildad y fe, se entrega a la misericordia del Rey—y recibe la promesa: "Hoy estarás conmigo en el Paraíso." Este encuentro nos recuerda que las puertas del Reino se abren no por nuestros méritos personales, sino por la misericordia y la gracia. La misericordia de Dios se derrama sobre quienes se acercan a El con corazón contrito y confianza de niño.

humildad comienza reconocimiento honesto de nuestra necesidad de gracia. La fe nos sostiene mientras caminamos hacia el Reino, confiando no en nuestras propias fuerzas, sino en el amor de Aquel que reina y nos salva desde la Cruz.

Así pues, al celebrar a Cristo nuestro Rey, renovemos nuestro compromiso de vivir como ciudadanos de su Reino—aquí y ahora. Seamos personas de misericordia, perdón y esperanza, sirviendo con alegría, edificando nuestra familia parroquial en el amor, y dando testimonio del reinado de Cristo en nuestra comunidad, comenzando en nuestros hogares.

Somos: una sola Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros. iAmén!
